NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF HEARING

June 14, 2010

On June 25, 2010, Hess Corporation filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of a 250 MMCFD addition to the Tioga Gas Plant consisting of various processing facilities, including a flare stack that will be located on an adjacent tract comprised of 21 acres in Williams County, North Dakota as shown on the attached map.

A Public Hearing on the application is scheduled to begin **on August 30, 2010 at 10 a.m. CDT in the Tioga City Hall, 12 1st Street NE, Tioga, ND 58852.** The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

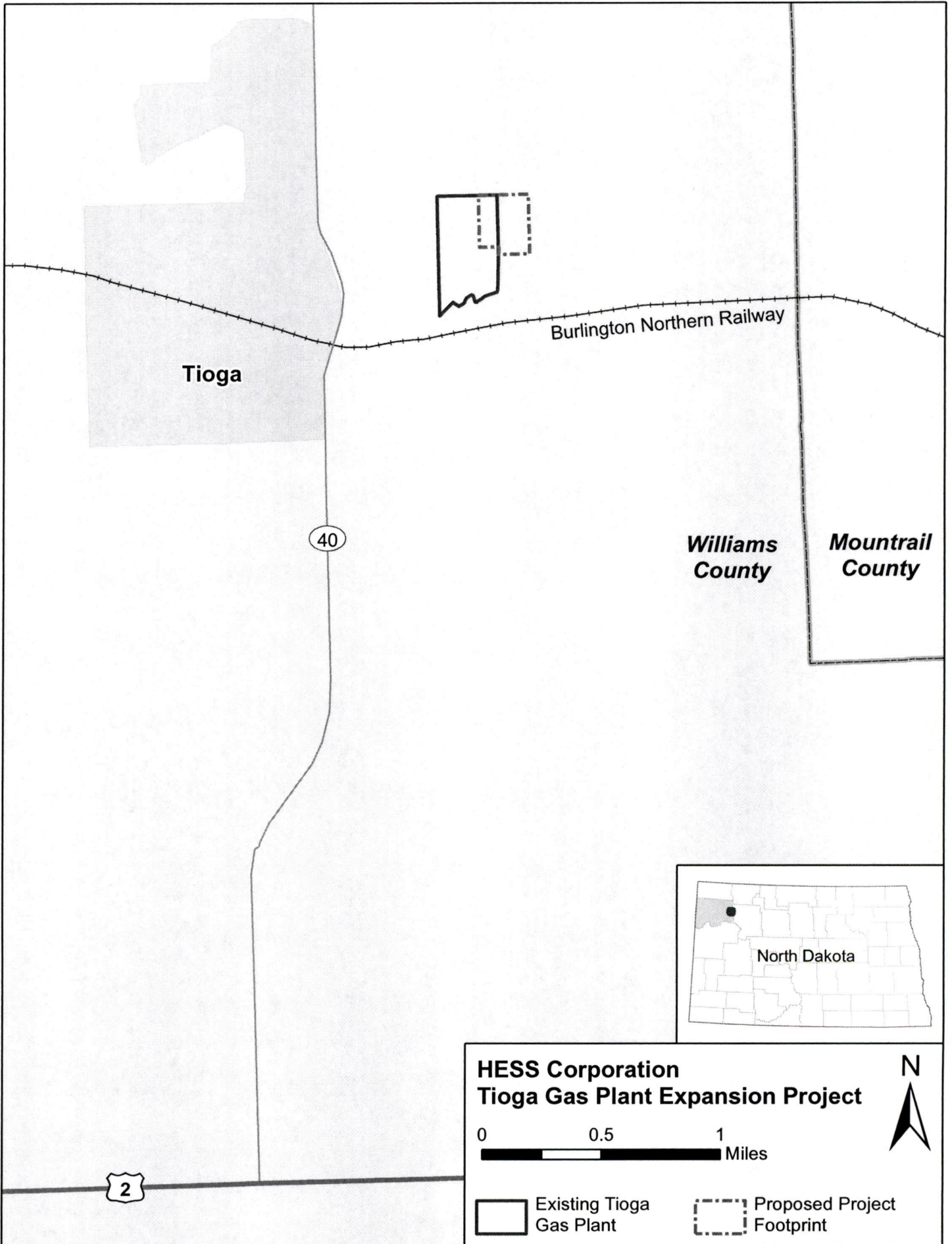
