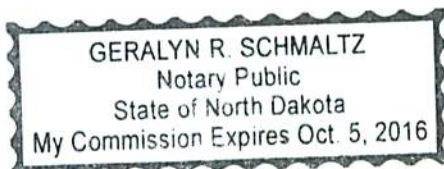


On April 16, 2012, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (MDU) filed an earnings sharing adjustment for the year ended 2011 pursuant to the Commission's Order issued June 8, 2011. The application to credit June and July 2012 bills for .41 cents per kWh would result in a total credit of \$6.15 for an average customer using 750 kWh per month.

The issue to be considered in this case is whether the application is fair and reasonable and in compliance with the Commission Order.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearings must be received by **June 16, 2012**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
