

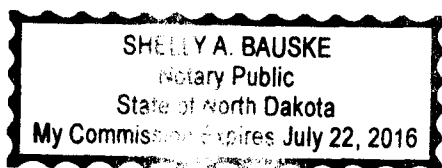

NOTICE OF HEARING
September 22, 2010

On August 4, 2010, the Commission issued an Order granting the application of Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (Enbridge) and issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 114 and Route Permit Number 124 authorizing construction and operation of upgrades to Enbridge's Berthold Station in Ward County, North Dakota. The Order was conditioned on Enbridge's compliance with local land use, zoning, and building rules, regulations and ordinances.


On September 20, 2010, Enbridge filed a Motion and supporting documents under N.D.C.C. § 49-22-16(2) asking the Commission to reopen the proceeding and supersede and preempt the City of Berthold's zoning decision.

A Public Hearing on this matter is scheduled to begin **November 5, 2010**, at **11:00 a.m. CDT**, at the **Berthold American Legion Hall, 30303 20th Ave SW, Berthold, North Dakota, 58718**.

The issue to be considered is whether the City of Berthold's rules, regulations, or ordinances, as applied to Enbridge's Berthold Station, are unreasonably restrictive in view of existing technology, factors of cost or economics, or needs of consumers regardless of their location.
