
Submitted with the application was a statement by Norman Wirtz that the customer desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

**The NE ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 25, Twp 130 N, R 49 W,
Richland County, North Dakota.**

Otter Tail Power Company has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **June 29, 2010**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
