**NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED
HEARING**
April 15, 2011

On February 7, 2011, Montana-
Dakota Utilities Co., a division
of MDU Resources Group, Inc.,
(MDU) filed an application for a
waiver of procedures and time
schedules, a corridor certificate
and a route permit to authorize
construction of approximately
30 miles of 230 kV electric
transmission line and associat-
ed facilities in Dickey and

McIntosh Counties of North
Dakota, as shown on the
attached map.

MDU requests the Commission
waive procedures and time
schedules set forth in North
Dakota Century Code chapter
49-22 and North Dakota
Administrative Code article 69-
06 to allow for a single consol-
idated application for corridor
certificate and route permit and
to hold a combined hearing on
the waiver request and applica-
tion for corridor certificate and
route permit.

On March 18, 2011 the
Commission issued a
Corrected Notice of Filing and
Notice of Hearing to be held
April 15, 2011. That public
hearing was cancelled due to
inclement weather and is now
rescheduled to begin May 12,

2011, at 2:00 p.m. CDT at the
Dickey County Courthouse,
309 2nd St, Ellendale, ND
58436. The issues to be con-
sidered are:

1. Will the location, construc-
tion, and operation of the pro-
posed facilities produce mini-
mal adverse effects on the
environment and upon the wel-
fare of the citizens of North
Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities
compatible with the environ-
mental preservation and the
efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility
locations minimize adverse
human and environmental
impact while ensuring continu-
ing system reliability and
integrity and ensuring that
energy needs are met and ful-
filled in an orderly and timely

fashion?

4. Is it appropriate for the
Commission to waive proced-
ures and time schedules as
requested, including the
request for a single consol-
idated application for corridor
certificate and route permit?
