Susan,

On June 1, I was notified about a mine-collapse sinkhole near the KDKT radio tower in the SW1/4 of Section 18, T144N, R87W, in Beulah. We plan to have this sinkhole repaired as soon as possible using federal emergency funds. Disturbance will be restricted to the immediate area of the sinkhole. We expect to fill the sinkhole partially with grout and to top it off with fill dirt, to divert drainage away from the repaired sinkhole, respread topsoil and seed the area. The sinkhole is about 28 feet in diameter with an average depth of 12 feet and maximum depth of 25 feet. It is located between two guy wire anchors for the radio tower. This sinkhole is a serious and immediate hazard to the public and meets criteria as an AML emergency.

I request your concurrence with a "No Historic Properties Affected" determination for this site. Attached are an AML emergency investigation report, maps and photographs of the site. If you have any questions or need more information, please contact me.
