On June 21, 2011, BakkenLink Pipeline, LLC (BakkenLink) filed applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit to authorize construction for approximately 144 miles of 8-inch and 12-inch crude oil pipeline in Billings, Dunn, McKenzie, Stark and Williams Counties, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The trunkline will have bi-directional capability, and will be able to transport crude oil between Beaver Lodge and a new rail facility at Fryburg, North Dakota. BakkenLink also filed a request

for waiver of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-22 and North Dakota Administrative Code Chapter 69-06-06. The Commission finds the applications are complete.

A Public Hearing on the applications is scheduled to begin September 1, 2011 at 10 a.m. CDT, McKenzie County Court House, 201 5th Street NW, Watford City, North Dakota, 58854. The issues to be considered are:

1. Is the proposed facility of such length, design, location, or purpose that it will produce minimal adverse effects, or, does a demonstrable emergency exist which requires immediate construction and that adherence to the procedures and time schedules would jeopardize the utility's system?
2. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
3. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
4. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

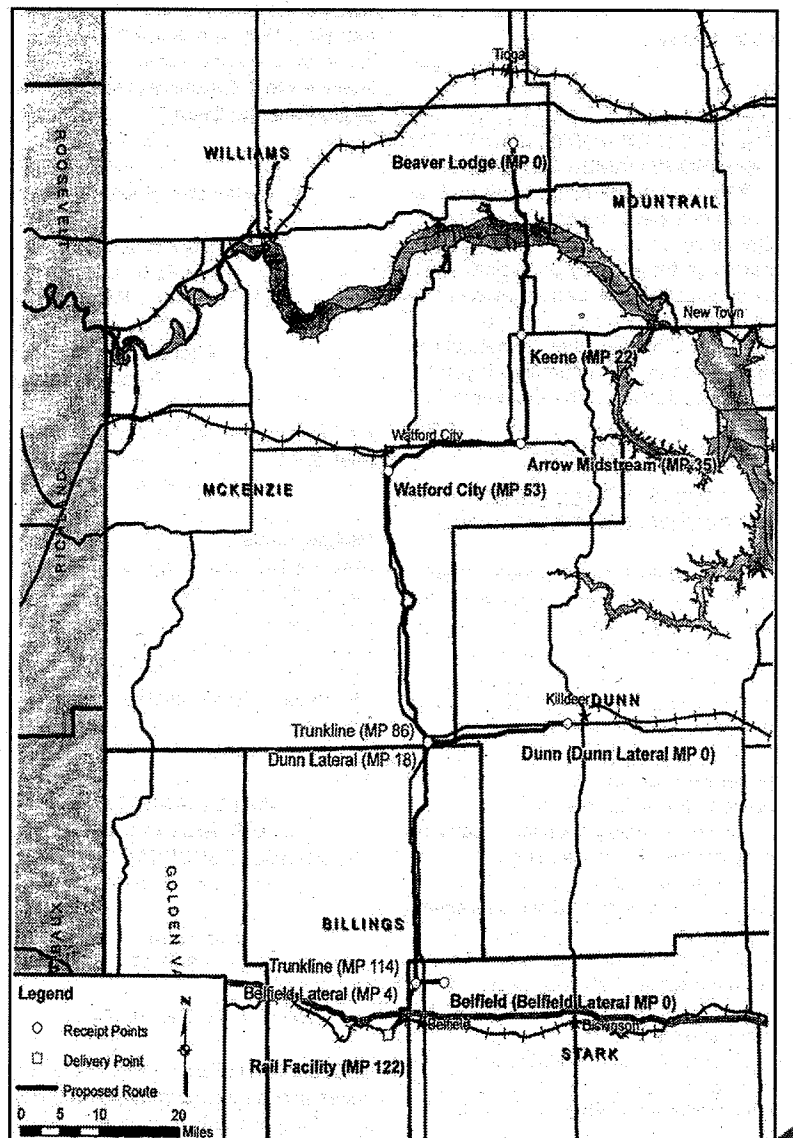

The terms of sale are as follows:

1. The City reserves the right to reject all bids, and to waive any irregularities in any bid.

The successful bidder will be expected to sign, within thirty days of acceptance of bid, a Purchase Agreement committing the successful bidder to build an industrial building on the lots purchased within two years from the date of closing, and each bid must identify what the bidder proposes to build and the size, construction cost, and business purpose of the proposed building.
4. All construction and subsequent use of the property must be consistent with the classification of the property as industrial for zoning purposes.
5. All bids must state the number of lots requested, and the dollar amount bid per lot.
6. The successful bidder will receive a quit claim deed from the City at the time of closing.
