

**NOTICE OF RESOLUTION
ESTABLISHING SUBDIVISION**

Notice is hereby given that a petition to establish the Countryside Estates Subdivision has been filed in the office of the McKenzie County Auditor. A hearing to determine the granting of said petition was held by the McKenzie County Board of Commissioners on Tuesday, August 2, 2011, beginning at 11:00 a.m. CST in the Commissioners Room of the McKenzie County Courthouse at 201 Fifth St NW, Watford City, North Dakota.

No parties having appeared in opposition to said subdivision, and appearing that all provisions of law had been met, it was moved by Commissioner Ron Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Rick Lawlar that the Countryside Estates subdivision as platted is accepted. The motion included a stipulation that a statement be added to the plat that there will be no county road services provided to the subdivision. The motion was passed on a vote of four ayes and one nay.

The plat of the proposed subdivision is available for inspection during regular business hours of the office of the McKenzie County Auditor at 201 Fifth St NW, Watford City, North Dakota.

The plat boundary description is as follows: A parcel of land particularly described NE1/4 of Section 34 of Township 150 North Range 99 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, McKenzie County, North Dakota.

NOTICE OF HEARING
August 3, 2011**

On June 21, 2011, BakkenLink Pipeline, LLC (BakkenLink) filed applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit to authorize construction for approximately 144 miles of 8-inch and 12-inch crude oil pipeline in Billings, Dunn, McKenzie, Stark and Williams Counties, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The trunkline will have bi-directional capability, and will be able to transport crude oil between Beaver Lodge and a new rail facility at Fryburg, North Dakota. BakkenLink also filed a request for waiver of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-22 and North Dakota Administrative Code Chapter 69-06-06. The Commission finds the applications are complete.

A Public Hearing on the applications is scheduled to begin September 1, 2011 at 10 a.m. CDT, McKenzie County Court House, 201 5th Street NW, Watford City, North Dakota, 58854. The issues to be considered are:

1. Is the proposed facility of such length, de-

sign, location, or purpose that it will produce minimal adverse effects, or, does a demonstrable emergency exist which requires immediate construction and that adherence to the procedures and time schedules would jeopardize the utility's system?

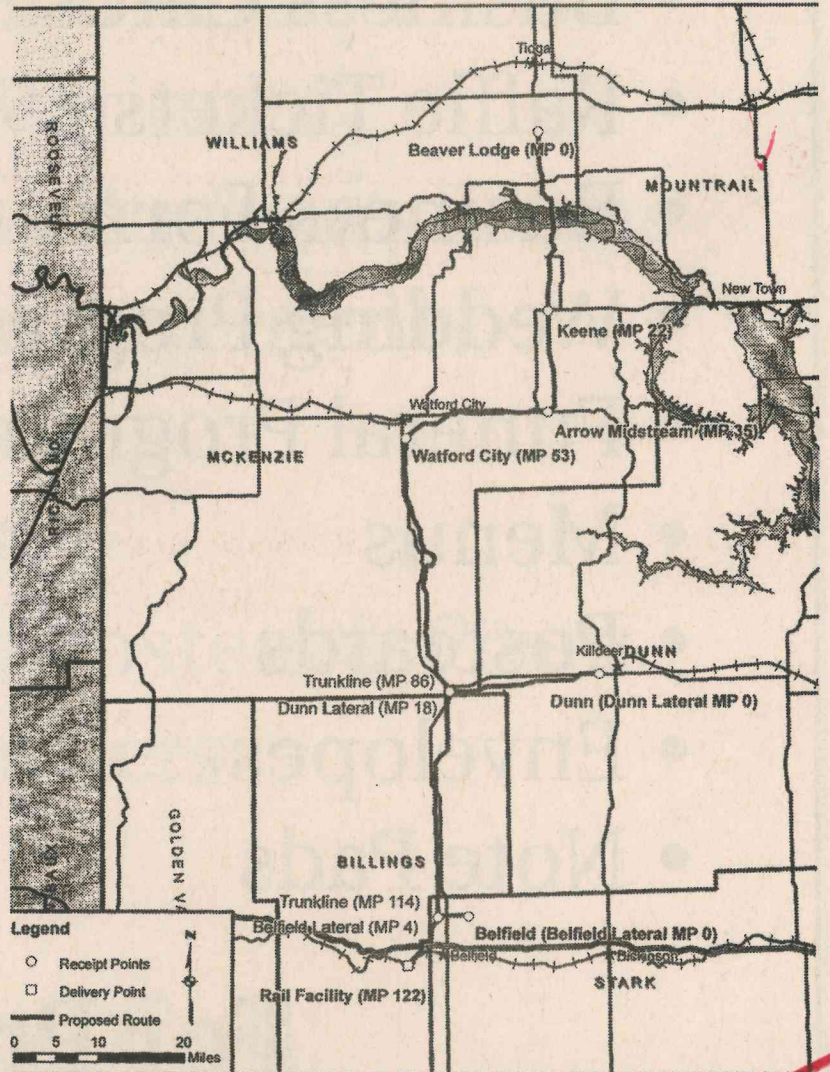
2. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

3. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?

4. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
