If load restrictions have not been lifted the NDDOT by May 28, 2012, time charges will start 7 calendar days after load restrictions have been lifted in the spring of 2012. The airport will be closed during Phase 2 only after the last commercial airline flight of each evening and construction (grooving and permanent marking of Runway 11-29) for that evening must be completed one (1) hour before the first commercial flight of each day.

The project shall be substantially completed (work substantially completed and the project entirely open and usable for the Owner) within the schedule provided for each phase of work.
