**CONSOLIDATED APPLICATION FOR AMENDED ORDER, THIRD
AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF CORRIDOR COMPATIBILITY AND
THIRD AMENDED ROUTE PERMIT**

On June 21, 2011, BakkenLink Pipeline LLC (“BakkenLink”) filed with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a Consolidated Application for a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit to authorize the construction of a crude oil pipeline project in Billings, Dunn, McKenzie, Stark and Williams Counties, North Dakota (the “BakkenLink Project”). *See* PSC Docket No. 9. On February 29, 2012, the Commission entered its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Order”) issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 128 and Route Permit Number 137 for the BakkenLink Project. *See* PSC Docket No. 72.

On July 24, 2012, BakkenLink filed with the Commission a request to amend the Order and seeking approval of modifications to the BakkenLink Project route and corridor. *See* PSC Docket No. 78. On August 1, 2012, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing on BakkenLink’s request to amend the Order and its application for a waiver of procedures and time schedules, with comments and requests for a hearing due by August 31, 2012. *See* PSC Docket No. 82. On September 5, 2012, the Commission entered its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Second Order”) granting the request for an amendment and issuing First Amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 128 and First Amended Route Permit Number 137 for the BakkenLink Project. *See* PSC Docket No. 93.

On January 18, 2013, BakkenLink filed a request for modification to the approved corridor and route to accommodate three (3) reroutes located in McKenzie County, North Dakota at landowner requests. *See* PSC Docket No. 114. On February 8, 2013, Commission Staff approved the reroutes conditioned on expiration of a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, to be issued by the Commission, and without receipt of any comments or requests for a hearing. *See* PSC Docket No. 122. On February 13, 2013, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing on BakkenLink’s request to amend the Second Order and its application for a waiver of procedures and time schedules, with comments and requests for a hearing due by March 18, 2013. *See* PSC Docket No. 125. On April 10, 2013, the Commission entered its Order (“Third Order”, and the Order, as amended by the Second Order and Third Order, collectively, the “BakkenLink Order”) granting BakkenLink’s application for a waiver of procedures and time schedules and issuing the Second Amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 128 and Second Amended Route Permit Number 137 for the BakkenLink Project. *See* PSC Docket No. 142.

Andeavor Field Services LLC (“Andeavor”) is the successor in interest to BakkenLink with respect to ownership of the BakkenLink Project. On February 5, 2018, Andeavor filed a consolidated application for a corridor certificate and route permit for the location of a natural gas liquids pipeline, approximately 22 miles long, in Billing and Stark Counties, and for four liquids product pipelines, each approximately 5 miles long, in Stark and Billings Counties, North Dakota (the “Andeavor Project”). *See* PSC Docket No. 1 in Case No. PU-18-72. On June 13, 2018, the Commission entered its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Andeavor Order”) issuing Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Numbers 205, 206 and 207 and Route Permit Numbers 215, 216 and 217 for the Andeavor Project. *See* PSC Docket No. 64 in Case No. PU-18-72.

The Andeavor Project interconnects with existing 42 mile BakkenLink Project (the “Existing BakkenLink Pipeline”) in Section 30, Township 149 North, Range 98 West, McKenzie County, North Dakota. *See* Andeavor Order, p. 3, ¶ 2. The Andeavor Order provides that “Andeavor shall cause the Permit issued in Case No. PU-10-218, BakkenLink Pipeline LLC, to be amended to allow for the transmission of NGLs prior to commencing transportation of NGLs.” *See* Andeavor Order, p. 9, ¶ 14. Accordingly, Andeavor submits this application to amend the BakkenLink Order to allow for the transmission of natural gas liquids and/or Y-Grade product through the Existing BakkenLink Pipeline.

Andeavor requests that the Commission waive the hearing requirement in its entirety and proceed by virtue of its notice and opportunity for hearing procedure in consideration of this application. In support of this request, Andeavor submits the following:

1. The Existing BakkenLink Pipeline is completed and no further disturbance through additional construction activity is anticipated with respect to this portion of the Andeavor Project.
2. Andeavor is merely seeking utilization of the previously constructed BakkenLink crude oil pipeline for the transmission of natural gas liquids and/or Y-Grade product, so no public opposition is anticipated given the current status of the Existing BakkenLink Pipeline.
3. Andeavor believes that the Commission has all the necessary information available in the submissions filed in Case No. PU-10-218 and Case No. PU-18-72 in order to issue a decision, thereby making the formal hearing process unnecessary.


Based on the Andeavor Order provisions, North Dakota Century Code Sections 49-22-08 and 49-22-08.1, and North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-02-02-04, Andeavor requests

the Commission issue an amendment to the BakkenLink Order to allow for the transmission of natural gas liquids and/or Y-Grade product through the Existing BakkenLink Pipeline together with the corresponding Third Amended Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Third Amended Route Permit in accordance with the Andeavor Order. For the reasons stated herein, Andeavor requests that the Commission waive the hearing requirement in its entirety and proceed by virtue of its notice and opportunity for hearing procedure in consideration of this application.



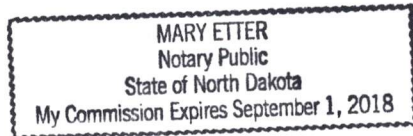
