Enclosed is North Dakota Facility-Based Grain Buyer License No. 2161 for New Rockford and relevant documents. Your license and each of the colored posters must be displayed at your New Rockford facility in an area easily visible by patrons.

State law requires that licensees submit monthly reports within 30 days of the end of each month. New Rockford has been assigned grain movement number **8185**. This number must be used on all monthly report forms which are available on the Commission's website at <http://psc.nd.gov/forms/grain/grain-movement-and-storage-report.pdf> or the forms can be filed electronically at <http://www.ugpti.org/grain/>.

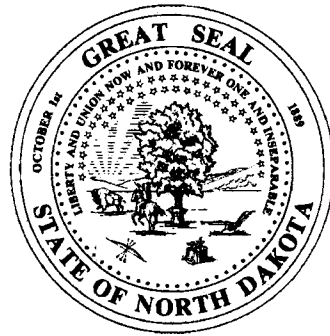
