**ORDER CANCELLING HEARING AND
GRANTING LICENSE APPLICATION**

August 4, 2010

North Dakota Oilseed Mills, LLC, Northwood, North Dakota filed an application for a public grain warehouse license, as provided for in North Dakota Century Code Section 60-02-07 to operate a 50,000-bushel grain warehouse at Northwood, North Dakota. North Dakota Oilseed Mills, LLC submitted a letter with the application, asking the Commission to determine the bond amount they will be required to file.

In the interim, the Commission asked North Dakota Oilseed Mills, LLC for more information which the company filed. The information was reviewed and analyzed by Commission staff. The Commission also received comments and letters from interested parties regarding the license application.

North Dakota Oilseed Mills, LLC, via e-mail, committed to filing a \$100,000 bond, and indicated their willingness to file a bond in an amount double the minimum required and do business on an immediate cash only basis.

Based up the information received the Commission believes the hearing should be cancelled and a license should be issued immediately conditioned on their compliance with law and e-mail commitments.

Therefore, the formal hearing scheduled to begin August 31, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. in the Commission Room, Grand Forks Office Building, 151 South 4th Street – 6th floor, Grand Forks, North Dakota is CANCELLED.


Order

The Commission orders:

1. The hearing scheduled for August 31, 2010, is cancelled.

2. A license shall be issued upon North Dakota Oilseed Mills, LLC's compliance with the following conditions precedent:
 - a. Satisfactory showing of statutory compliance;
 - b. Submission of a \$100,000 bond; and
 - c. Written assurance that all scale tickets issued for grain received will be immediately converted into cash.


