Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. operated a grain warehouse at Clyde, North Dakota until its license was revoked in February 2010. Since that time, the Commission has been made aware that Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. defaulted on payments for grain purchases.


Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. informed the Commission that there are outstanding accounts receivable for grain and grain product assets. Therefore, when the Public Service Commission filed its Application for Appointment as Trustee in the Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. insolvency, the Commission asked that the Court order the licensee to turn over these accounts receivable to the Commission.

On 31 August 2010, District Judge Laurie Fontaine issued an Order appointing the Commission trustee of the trust fund for the purpose of marshalling all trust assets of the Insolvency Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. The Order provided that accounts receivable as provided in North Dakota Century Code Section 60-04-03.1 shall be forwarded to the Commission to be included as an asset of the trust fund.
