
Dear Judge Geiger:

This is to advise the Court that the Public Service Commission as Trustee and Claimants Merlyn and Dolores Grabanski and Louie Slominski Jr. have resolved their claims regarding the Grabanski Grain LLC insolvency proceeding. The parties agree that all drying charges will be offset against allowed claims, and agree on the amount of the claims to be considered valid. Formal settlement documents will be forthcoming to the Court but as the Court has set today as a deadline to submit briefs, we thought it prudent to advise the Court to the status of these matters. No issues regarding these two claims remain in dispute and neither of these claimants nor the Public Service Commission will be briefing any issues related to the Merlyn and Dolores Grabanski and Louis Slominski, Jr. claims.

Ms. Jeffcoat-Sacco has reviewed this letter and has agreed to its content. We apologize for submission of this information to the Court close to the briefing deadline but the parties just late yesterday afternoon confirmed the resolution of the disputes regarding these claims.
