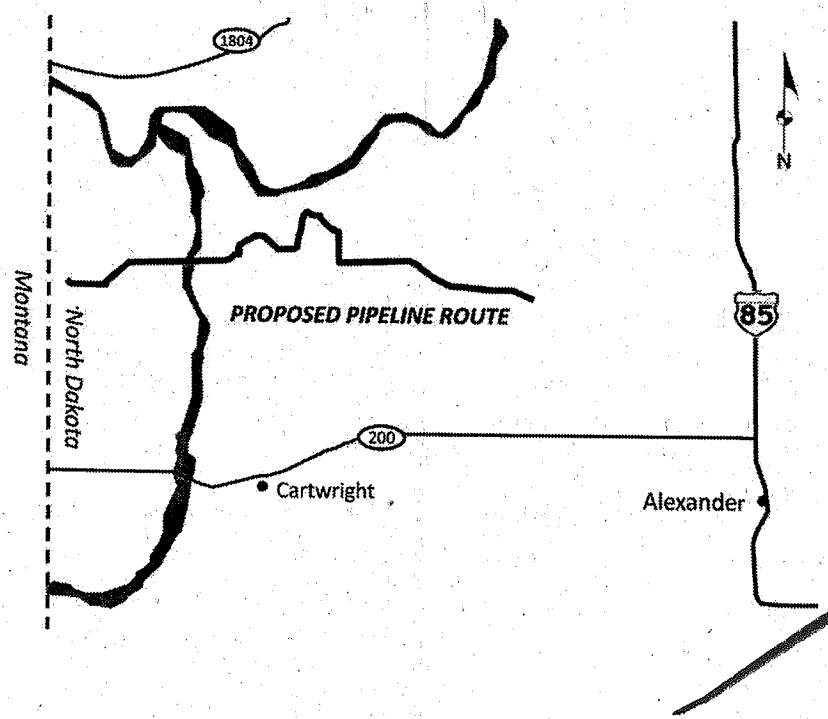

On August 1, 2011, Arrow filed an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules including:

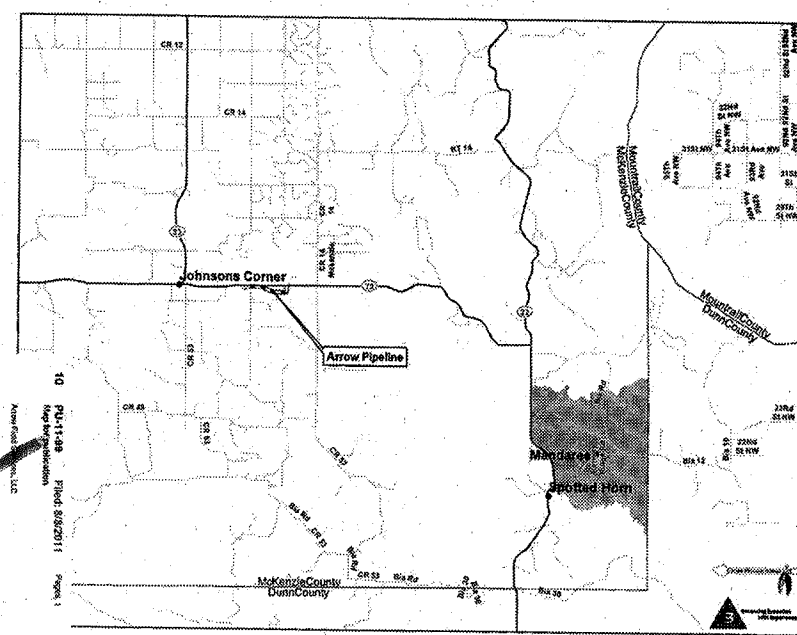
