On July 12, 2011, Hiland Operating, LLC (Hiland) filed an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and an application for a route permit to authorize the construction and operation of approximately 14.1 miles of 6-inch natural gas liquids pipeline originating at Hiland's natural gas processing plant four miles north and eight miles east of Cartwright and terminating at Hiland's rail loading facility along the Yellowstone Valley Railroad, all in McKenzie County, North Dakota. The project is shown on the attached map.

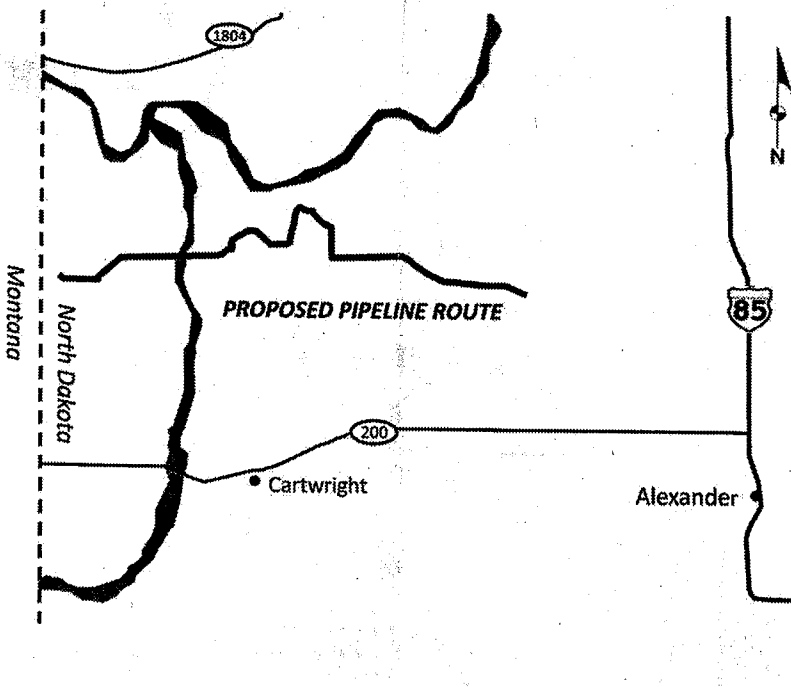

On July 22, 2011, Arrow Field Services, LLC (Arrow) filed an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and an application for a route permit to authorize the construction and operation of a 1.5-mile 8-inch crude oil pipeline originating at Arrow's existing CDP Connect Facility and terminating at an interconnect with the existing 4 Bears Pipeline, all in McKenzie County, North Dakota. The project is shown on the attached map.

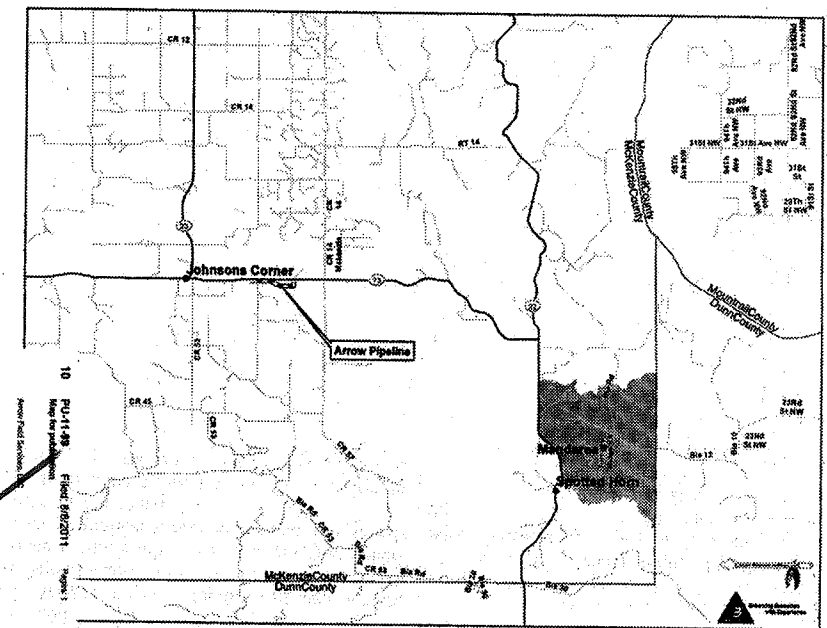
