NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF HEARING

November 2, 2010

On October 13, 2010, Hiland Operating, LLC (Hiland) filed a combined application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit to authorize construction for approximately 5.1 miles of 8-inch crude oil pipeline in McKenzie County of North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. The Commission finds the combined application is complete.

A **Public Hearing** on the combined application is scheduled to begin **Friday, December 10, 2010 at 10 a.m. CST, at the McKenzie County Court House, 201 5th Street NW, Watford City, North Dakota, 58854.** The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

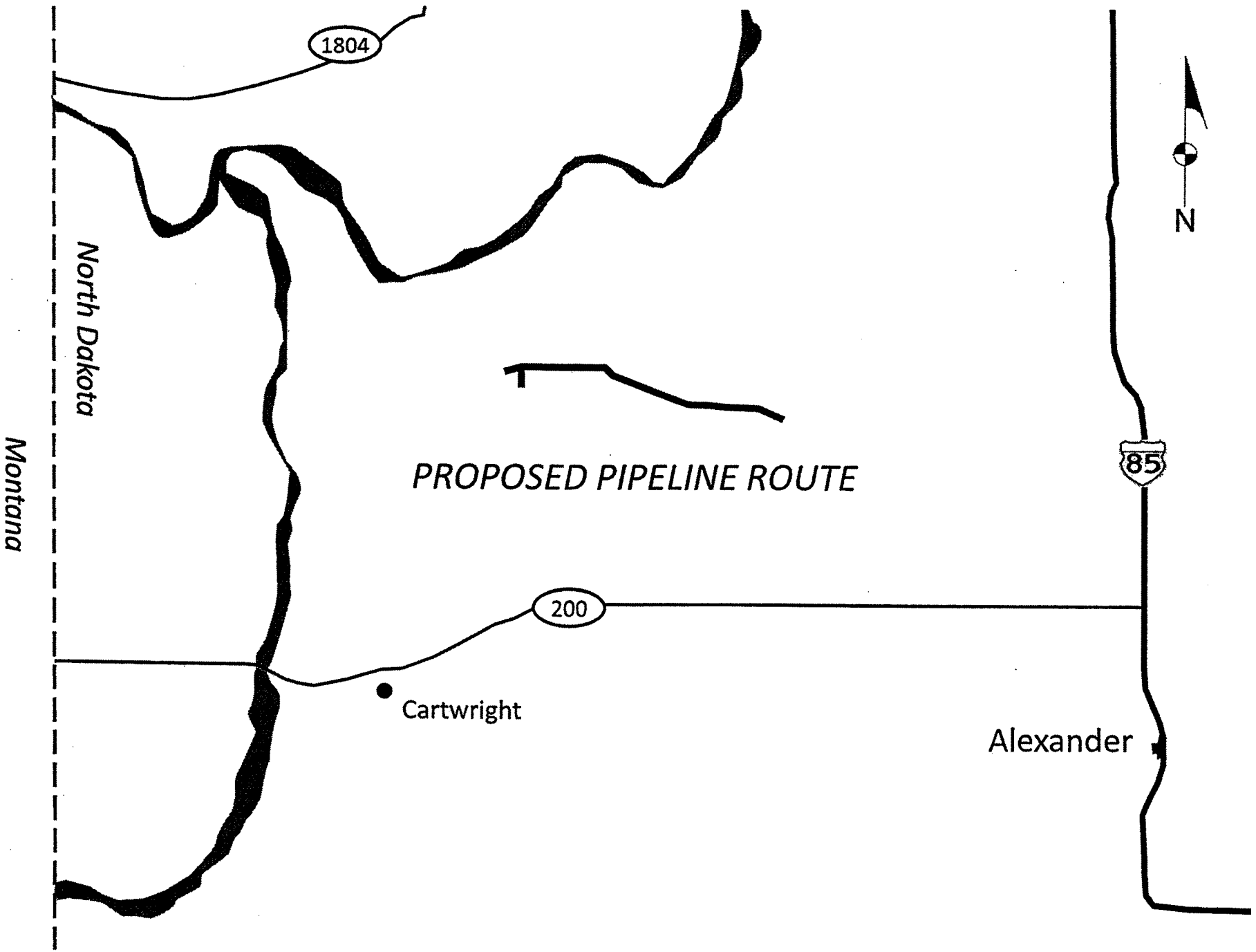
