Ordinance No. 223
An Ordinance Amending Section 7-219 of Article 2, Chapter VII of the City of Watford City Ordinances Regarding Dog and Cat Penalties

7-219 Penalty
 A violation of any provision of this Article is an infraction, for which the maximum penalty is a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
 Any person convicted of an infraction who has, within one year prior to commission of the infraction, been previously convicted of an offense classified as an infraction, may be sentenced as though convicted of a Class B Misdemeanor. If the prosecution contends that the infraction is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, the Complaint shall specify that the offense is a Class B Misdemeanor.

While the maximum penalty for a violation of any provision of this Article is a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), the following mandatory minimum penalties also apply:
 f. Appearance in Court is mandatory for a violation of any provision of this Article, EXCEPT Article 7-206 (Impounding), Article 7-218 (Pet solid waste) and for first offenses for violations of Article 7-201 (License Required), Article 7-205 (Dog or Cat Running At Large Prohibited), and Article 7-209 (Noisy Dog or Cat Prohibited). Any person failing to appear before the Court at the time and place designated in the COMPLAINT may be charged with a separate offense, FAILURE TO APPEAR, a Class B Misdemeanor. The maximum penalty for a Class B Misdemeanor is a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), a thirty (30) day jail sentence, or both.

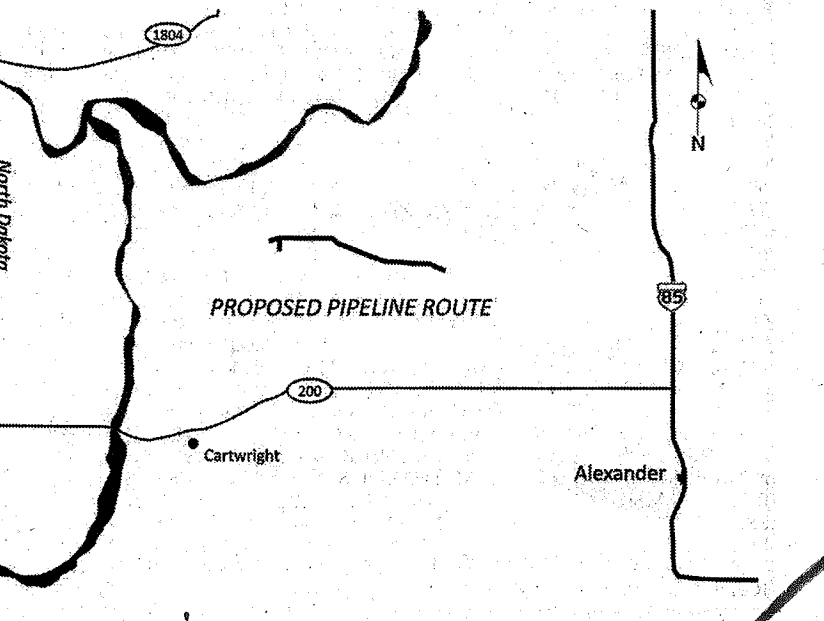
