Mr. Fahn,

At 1:30 PM on Monday, May 9th a Westcon Industries worker was assisting in the loading of 2 inch piping in a pipe rack at the Garden Creek Plant. This 2 inch piping is to be placed on rollers in the pipe rack and needs occasional guidance from workers to guide the pipe on to the rollers. The worker attempted to adjust the piping onto the roller using her hands and pinched her right pinkie finger. The worker was wearing gloves at the time. The worker sustained a 1 1/2 inch laceration on her right hand and broke the metacarpal bone of her right pinkie finger. The worker has received medical attention to set the bone and bandage the wound. The worker is currently assigned to light work duty. Westcon Industries is a sub-contractor who is working for Linde Process Plants. Linde will be providing a report to Bear Paw on this injury.
