A building permit will be acquired prior to construction.</p> <p>Lignite Station: On January 18, 2011 the Burke County Planning & Zoning Committee considered and recommended approval of Enbridge’s application for a rezoning of land for its Lignite Station. The Burke County Board of Commissioners concurred with the Planning & Zoning Committee’s recommendation. Receipt of formal approval is pending.</p>
