Dear Mr. Nitschke:

Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (hereinafter "EPND") is hereby filing certain information to supplement its *Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit* application ("Application") in the above-referenced proceeding. The purpose of this supplemental filing is to provide additional information obtained since the original filing of this application on November 5, 2010. Thus, EPND is enclosing herein for filing the original and ten copies of Late Filed Exhibits BP-4 and BP-5. The additional cultural resource investigations (performed by Kadrmas, Lee and Jackson ("KL&J"), *Exhibit BP-4*) and the related correspondence letters from the State Historical Society of North Dakota ("SHPO", *Exhibit BP-5*), as described in more details below.

As stated in the originally filed Application, KL&J conducted additional review and surveys of the survey corridor after submittal. KL&J completed two Class III Cultural Resource Inventory reports based on these additional surveys, one addressing additional survey areas along the pipeline route (Report of Investigation 1256), and one addressing the proposed Kenaston and Lignite Pumping Stations (Report of Investigation 1265). These reports are submitted as *Exhibit BP-4*.

Both reports were submitted to SHPO for review and comment. In its January 24, 2011 correspondence, SHPO concurred with KL&J's "No Historic Properties Affected" and "No Significant Sites Affected" determination with respect to Report of Investigation 1265. With respect to Report of Investigation 1256, in its January 11, 2011, correspondence, SHPO concurred with KL&J's "No Historic Properties Affected" and "No Significant Sites Affected" with the condition that site 32BK0090 be avoided by at least 250 feet. Upon further consultation and review regarding site 32BK0090, in its January 27, 2011,

correspondence, SHPO concurred with the "No Historic Properties Affected" recommendation. SHPO's correspondence is submitted as *Exhibit BP-5*.
