## Commissions Order Case #PU-10-613 & PU-10-612 - Beaver Lodge Loop Project

- Reviewed PU-10-613 - Certifications Relating to Order Provisions – Transmission Facility Siting
  - Certification was signed by Richard Adams stating the promises made by Enbridge to the Commission.
  - #1 – Comments:
    1. Mr. Fahn: Chapter 49-22 contains the Siting Act and Chapter 69-06-08 contains the rules.
  - #3 – Comments:
    1. Mr. Fahn: Noted that when he uses the words “transmission facility”, pumping stations are included in that category.
  - #4 – Comments:
    1. Mr. Fahn: “Do we have all the licenses & permits?” James Watts: “It is my understanding that we have obtained all licenses & permits and have no others to supply you at this time.”
  - #5 – Comments:
    1. Mr. Fahn: “Are you going to be filing separate weekly reports for Facilities versus Mainline?” James Watts: “Yes, Facilities will provide their own weekly reports...Facilities will have different construction start dates than Mainline.” Mr. Fahn: “Will different people be filing the reports?” James Watts: “Yes, Grant Henningsen will originate or assign the task of submitting a weekly construction report on behalf of Facilities.” Grant Henningsen: “I will ensure the reports are collected weekly and Ken Collins will be issuing the Bakken Facilities Report.”
    2. Mr. Fahn noted that the reports should be sent to the general email address and cc'ed to Patrick Fahn. The first page of the report needs to have a 1.3” margin at the bottom for their docket sticker.
  - #6 – Comments:
    1. Mr. Fahn: “Will Facilities be working with the piping coming into the yard?” Grant Henningsen “Yes, we will be coordinating with Mainline where the piping comes into the specific terminals.” Mr. Fahn: “Then you need to be aware of #6.”

    1. Mr. Fahn would like to refer to the document about penalty provisions that he sent out. He also asked that attendees review the penalty provision document in relation to this provision.

Mr. Fahn: “Is there an environmental person onboard for Facility Construction?” James Watts: “Paul Meneghini is the Environmental Lead for the Bakken Project and he & his team will monitor and oversee the environmental inspectors for both Mainline & Facilities.” Grant Henningsen agreed and added that the Field Inspection staff will also monitor.

Is the topsoil already removed from the areas of constructions?” Volmer Anderson: “On the Greenfield sites (Kenaston & Lignite), the topsoil will be stripped...and used to landscape the station property.” Mr. Fahn: “That wouldn’t be used to contain spills would it?” Volmer Anderson: “No.” “The existing Terminals have no topsoil remaining at this point.”
