ORDINANCE
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY PRESENTLY LOCATED OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF NEW TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW TOWN, MOUNTRAIL COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA:

The City Council of the City of New Town, North Dakota, pursuant to Chapter, 40-51.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, states that:

1)FD Development of New Town, LLC, a subsidiary of Triple C Development, Inc., the owner of the following described real property, has presented to the City of New Town a written petition for annexation into the corporate boundaries of the City of New Town, North Dakota; and

2)All of the below-described real property is lands that are contiguous or adjacent real property which is within the corporate limits of the City of New Town;

3)The real property is fully described as follows, to-wit:

The South 100' less North 10' of Lot 1; and Lot 2, Less the West 10' thereof, Block 3, Highland Village Subdivision to the City of New Town, Mountrail County, North Dakota.

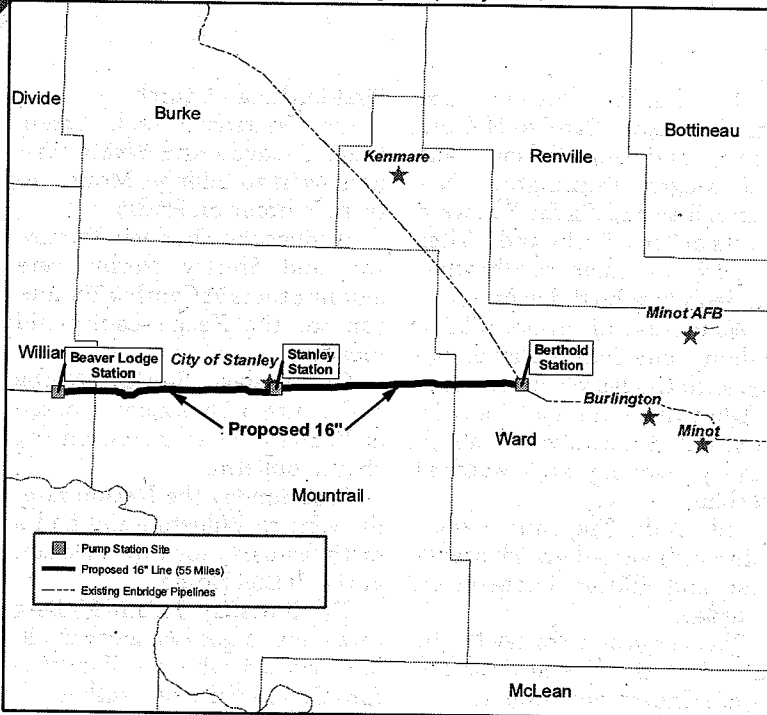
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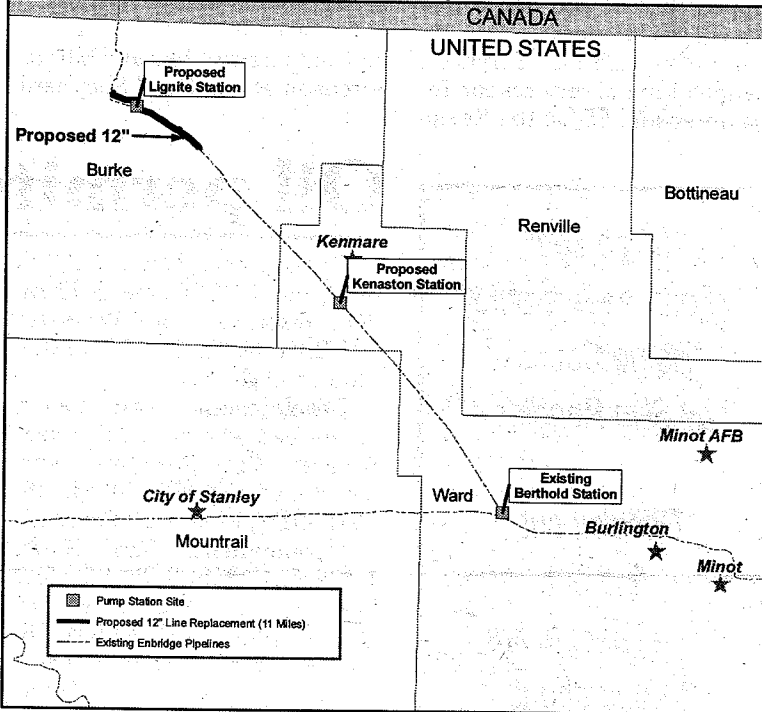

NOTICE OF FILINGS AND NOTICE OF HEARINGS
December 8, 2010

On November 5, 2010, Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (Enbridge) filed an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility and an application for a route permit to authorize construction for approximately 11 miles of 12-inch crude oil pipeline, to authorize construction of a new pumping station located near Kenaston, a new pump station near Lignite and station modifications at the existing Berthold Pump Station, all in Burke and Ward Counties, North Dakota, Case No. PU-10-612. The project is shown on the attached map. Enbridge also filed an application to waive and reduce procedures and time schedules required under North Dakota Century Code chapter 49-22 which require separate filings of applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility

Station and Berthold Station, all in Williams, Mountrail, and Ward Counties, North Dakota, Case No. PU-10-613. The project is shown on the attached map. Enbridge also filed an application to waive and reduce procedures and time schedules required under North Dakota Century Code chapter 49-22 which require separate filings of applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit, require separate notices of such applications, require separate hearings on such applications and require certain time schedules and requested that the applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit be consolidated into one application.

Public Hearings on the applications are scheduled to begin January 20, 2011 at 10 a.m. CST at the City Hall Auditorium, 5 3rd Ave NE, Kenmare, North Dakota, 58746. The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met
