1. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (COE) Omaha District - Nationwide Permit (NWP) 12 Section 404 Permit	Anticipated submittal: February 2011 Anticipated issuance: May 2011
2. COE-Omaha District/North Dakota State Historic Preservation Office (NDSHPO) National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), Section 106 Compliance	NDSHPO concurred in August 13, 2010 and on January 20, 2011 responding with a “No Historic Properties Affected” determination, provided certain identified sites are avoided or properly mitigated. Exhibits BL-4 (Class 3 Survey by KLJ re re-routes) and BL-5 (SHPO concurrence correspondence) will be filed with the PSC upon receipt.
3. U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Agency (USFWS) – Endangered Species Act Section 7 Compliance	Consultation initiated April 2010. To address biological resources concerns, EPND commissioned a habitat assessment of the study area in August 2010; aerial raptor surveys to be conducted prior to construction (Spring 2011).
4. USFWS - Wetland and Grassland Easements	Enbridge identified 40 parcels crossed by the proposed alignment that have USFWS wetland and/or grassland easements. After a comprehensive review, the Enbridge multiple pipeline right easement precedes the USFWS easements on 39 of the 40 properties. On the one parcel in question, Enbridge plans on avoiding the wetlands by slightly extending a road bore and making minor centerline adjustments to avoid the wetlands.

3. NDDH -Construction Stormwater and Temporary Dewatering General Permit (NDR10-0000) and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)	Anticipated submittal: April 2011 Anticipated issuance: May 2011

5. North Dakota State Land Department (NDSLD) – License to Cross School Trust Lands	Enbridge contacted the NDSLD regarding crossing the lands in October 2010. To follow up with that contact, Enbridge met with NDSLD staff on December 20, 2010. Based on verbal feedback at the meeting, staff agreed with Enbridge’s routing across the three School Trust properties.
6. North Dakota Game and Fish (NDGF) – State-Protected Species and Critical Habitat Review	Consultation initiated April 2010; Enbridge commissioned a habitat assessment in August 2010 and aerial raptor surveys to be conducted prior to construction (Spring 2011) to address agency concerns.
7. North Dakota State Water Commission (NDSWC) -Temporary Water Permit/Water Withdrawal Permit	Anticipated submittal: 3 rd Quarter 2011 Anticipated issuance: 4 th Quarter 2011

1. Railroad Crossings	Under the proposed alignment, Enbridge will need to obtain two railroad crossing permits from Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad. Enbridge is currently preparing applications for the crossing permits.
2. Road Crossings	There is a proposed crossing of North Dakota State Highway 8 which will require a permit from ND DOT. Enbridge is also aware of county highway and township road crossings in Williams, Mountrail and Ward counties which will require crossing permits. Enbridge is currently in the process of preparing and submitting the necessary applications.

3. Zoning	The sole pending zoning matter is related to Enbridge's proposed Beaver Lodge facility. By February 1, 2011, Enbridge will submit its application to Williams County for rezoning of certain property at its proposed Beaver Lodge Facility. The PSC will be provided with the results of that application after its completion that process; Enbridge envisions completion of that process by late-March.
