Additional Cultural Resource Investigations and SHPO correspondence

Dear Mr. Nitschke:

Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (hereinafter "EPND") is hereby filing certain information to supplement its *Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and Route Permit* application ("Application") in the above-referenced proceeding. The purpose of this supplemental filing is to provide additional information obtained since the original filing of this application on November 17, 2010. Thus, EPND is enclosing herein for filing the original and ten copies of Late Filed Exhibits BL-4 and BL-5. The additional cultural resource investigations (performed by Kadrmas, Lee and Jackson ("KL&J"), *Exhibit BL-4*) and the related correspondence from the State Historical Society of North Dakota ("SHPO", *Exhibit BL-5*), as described in more details below.

As stated in the originally filed Application, five cultural resource sites within the survey corridor were unevaluated for listing on the National Register of Historic Places ("NRHP") and required additional evaluation (see Exhibits C.1 and C.2 of the Application). The results of KL&J's additional survey and testing work for the five cultural resource sites are submitted herein as Reports of Investigation 1255¹ and 1268², collectively *Exhibit BL-4*.

Both Reports of Investigation were submitted to SHPO for review and comment. Based on the Reports of Investigation, as well as additional correspondence with SHPO, the following has been agreed to with respect to each site:

¹Report of Investigation 1255 describes additional survey and testing work completed by KL&J at sites 32MN460, 32MN843, 32MN845, and 32MN846.

²Report of Investigation 1268 describes additional survey and testing work completed by KL&J at site 32MN844.

32MN843: In its January 20, 2011, correspondence SHPO concurred with KL&J's "No Historic Properties Affected" and "No Significant Sites Affected" determination, provided that previously surveyed reroutes be utilized to avoid impacts. As a result of a February 9, 2011, meeting between SHPO and KL&J, Enbridge is proposing a minor reroute to completely avoid this site;

32MN844: In its January 20, 2011, correspondence SHPO concurred with KL&J's "No Historic Properties Affected" and "No Significant Sites Affected" determination. As a result of a February 9, 2011, meeting between SHPO and KL&J and SHPO's concurrence letter dated February 17, 2011, Enbridge has agreed to maintain a 50' buffer as the preferred method of avoidance, but that the buffer may be smaller to allow for construction provided the surface expression of the features is not impacted and archaeological monitors are present during construction;

32MN845: In its January 20, 2011, correspondence SHPO concurred with KL&J's "No Historic Properties Affected" and "No Significant Sites Affected" determination, provided that previously surveyed reroutes be utilized to avoid impacts;

32MN846: Site recommended as *not eligible* for additional historical research. No specific avoidance/treatment required; and

32MN460: In its January 20, 2011, correspondence SHPO concurred with KL&J's "No Historic Properties Affected" and "No Significant Sites Affected" determination. As a result of a February 9, 2011, meeting between SHPO and KL&J and SHPO's concurrence letter dated February 17, 2011, Enbridge has been permitted to perform construction along the proposed corridor provided an archaeological monitor is on site during construction.

Copies of the January 20 and February 17, 2011, correspondence from the SHPO are submitted as *Exhibit BL-5*.
