

This letter supplements my letter of March 24, 2011. I write this letter on behalf of Mountrail County. I do not have any authority to make further response on behalf the City of Stanley or Idaho Township.

Since the time of my last letter, the Mountrail County Commissioners have met and instructed me to inform the Public Service Commission that the Mountrail County Commissioners agree to the following:

- 1) That for three (3) miles commencing at the intersection of 84th Ave. NW and 61st St. NW, thence in an easterly direction along 61st St. NW ending at the intersection of 61st St. NW and North Dakota Highway 8, Enbridge shall:
 - A) Place all pipeline at a minimum depth of six (6) feet below ground level;
 - B) All pipe placed into the ground shall have an increased (thicker) wall; and,
 - C) Pay the incremental costs that the County may incur during the installation of future sewer and water lines that are directly caused by the installation of Enbridge's pipeline along this corridor.

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The County Commissioners also request that in the future Enbridge do a better job of notifying the governmental entities that are impacted by the expansion of Enbridge's facilities in the State of North Dakota. In this case, Mountrail County was first notified of Enbridge's pipeline expansion project three (3) days before the Public Service Commission's hearing in this matter. Better and more timely communication by Enbridge to Mountrail County in regards to this project would have allowed the Mountrail County Commissioners sufficient time to respond to Enbridge's plans prior to the Public Service Commission's meeting.

The Mountrail County Commissioners hope that in the future Enbridge would meet earlier in this process with the Mountrail County Board of Commissioners. The Mountrail County Board of County Commissioners believe that timely communication would go along way in achieving a friendly and professional relationship between Enbridge and Mountrail County.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, Farmers Union Oil Company, having an address of P.O. Box 459, Stanley, North Dakota 58784, as GRANTOR, and Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC, having an address of 119 North 25th Street East, Superior, Wisconsin 54880, as GRANTEE, have entered into an Option for Right-of-Way and Easement Grant pertaining to the property described on Exhibit A until October 31, 2011.

Said Option for Right-of-Way and Easement Grant contains provisions to the effect that GRANTEE may use said lands as described on Exhibit A and that GRANTOR has consented to such use upon the terms of the Easement Agreement.

This Memorandum of Option for Right-of-Way and Easement Grant is intended for notification purposes only. The Option for Right-of-Way and Easement Grant is not recorded and contains additional provisions not included in this Memorandum. In the event of conflict between this Memorandum and the unrecorded Option for Right-of-Way and Easement Grant, the unrecorded Option for Right-of-Way and Easement Grant shall control.

Multiple Grantors and Grantees may execute separate original counterparts of this Agreement and such execution shall have the same effect as if each signatory executed the same counterpart. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one integrated agreement.
