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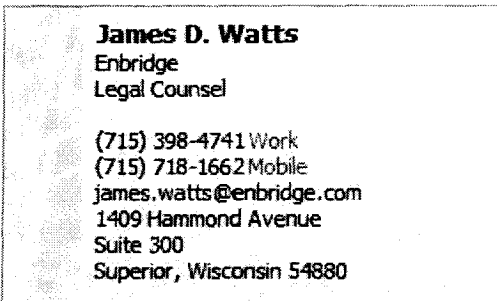

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1. **Commissions Order Case #PU-10-612 & PU-10-613 – Bakken Pipeline Project (US) and Beaver Lodge Loop Project, respectively**
  - Reviewed PU-10-613 (“Beaver Lodge Loop Project”) Certifications of Order Provisions
    - #1 – No further discussion.
    - #3 – No further discussion.
    - #4 – Comments:
      1. Patrick Fahn: “Who knows if there are any licenses or permits that need to be obtained yet?” Bruce in Minot responded, “We have a couple environmental permits for hydrotesting yet to get.”
      2. Randy Rice: We have a couple road permits and the hydrotest water testing pending but in process.
      3. Railroad permit is in hand but making adjustment for uncased crossing which they are working on and have agreed to verbally, but are in process of delivering permit to us.
      4. Patrick: Hard copies of permits are to be provided in hard copy to Commission’s Executive of Secretary (same address).
      5. Jim Watts forwarded landowner residents waivers for pump station project out of Minot, please also send hard copy.
    - #5 – Comments:
      1. Inform Commission of the date construction start, this will trigger day one of the first weekly report. Example: If construction starts on a Tuesday the following Tuesday the report is due.
      2. This must be prior to your construction.
      3. First page of weekly report you need 1.3” margin at bottom as a minimum.

  1. Is it a manual of sampling method to be used regarding tree and shrub inventory that may be removed?
    - a. Mainline portion will be a manual count of trees and shrubs impacted.
    - b. No clearing will occur at Stanley or Beaver Lodge Stations.

  1. Patrick comments he is curious as he understands the pipeline or cathodic protection can cause interference.
    - a. Enbridge has no knowledge of this but Enbridge doesn't intend to interfere with any transmissions.

1. Does Enbridge have a procedure or want to indicate to Commission how it is handled?
    - a. Enbridge has a plan to handle the procedure.
    - b. Kelly Rask, of Enbridge is to submit the plan and contact list to Lisa Wilson who will forward to Commission.

    1. Patrick states he does not intend to do this at this time.

- Order for Beaver Lodge Loop Project
    - #12 Findings of Facts
      1. Enbridge will comply with US Fish & Wildlife recommendations as found in Exhibit F-1 of Application.
        - a. Yes, ML confirms.
      2. Retain qualified biologist to complete Plover nesting study.
        - a. Enbridge has completed study. Results will be filed hard copy to the Commission.
    - Archeological sites – Finding of Fact #15
      1. Noted near construction area: The archeological sites will be avoided by narrowing or realigning construction corridor, and marking 50' buffer around archeological features.
        - a. Enbridge confirms this is the plan.
    - Finding of Fact #21
      1. Enbridge is submitting route deviation in the vicinity of Stanley, ND along 61<sup>st</sup> Street NW between State Hwy 8 and 82<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW. Sounds as though Enbridge is close to making the filing during conversation with Jim Watts.
        - a. Stanley reroute is not part of the preconstruction conference today. Enbridge is currently working with city engineers and once planning is completed, Enbridge will file route deviation. This will not be constructed in 2011; it will be constructed in 2012.
        - b. The preconstruction conference today discusses the Bakken Pipeline Project, our 11 mile replacement, and then the construction that will occur on Beaver Lodge Loop Line from Stanley going east to Berthold.
    - Finding of Fact #25
      1. Enbridge has developed Environmental Mitigation Plan and Spill Prevention Contaminant and Control Plan. Design of the facility will be in accordance with the US Dept. of Transportation Title 49 CFR Parts 194 and 195 of.
        - a. Enbridge agrees.
    - Finding of Fact #27
      1. Enbridge will implement the public awareness program that complies with the federal regulations. Establish liaison with local emergency response officials.
    - Finding of Fact #28

1. ND One Call Notification system. Enbridge to notify Commission as soon as reasonably possible upon damage of any facility conducted under the permit issued in this proceeding.
  - Ordering paragraph – Stanley construction will not begin before application for route deviation is filed with Commission and approved.
  - #5 of Ordering Paragraph – Enbridge to notify Commission as soon as reasonably possible if any damage as defined by ND 49/23 (One Call) to underground facilities. In the event of any damage to underground facilities, Enbridge suspends construction within vicinity of damage and show compliance with one call notification system requirements under ND 49/23 until cleared by Commission.
  - #6 of Ordering Paragraph – Reviewed.

Patrick Fahn: Order for Bakken Pipeline Project

- Finding of Fact on Page 5
  - #15 discusses avoidance areas – One of the areas is a wetland, Enbridge will seek US Army Corps of Engineer Nationwide permit authorizing temporary wetland impacts.
    - This permit has been received by Enbridge.
    - Enbridge to provide Commission with said permit.
  - Commission to receive minutes before Enbridge begins construction.
