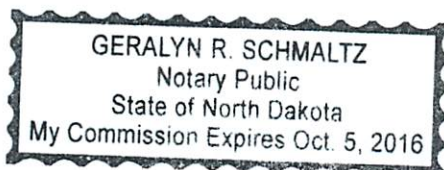

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**NOTICE OF FILINGS, NOTICE OF INFORMAL HEARING, AND NOTICE OF
OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

August 3, 2011

The North Dakota Public Service Commission's (Commission) May 18, 2011 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued to Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota), LLC (Enbridge) a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and a Route Permit for the construction of the Beaver Lodge Loop Project located in Williams, Mountrail and Ward Counties, North Dakota. The Beaver Lodge Loop Project consists of approximately 56 miles of 16-inch diameter crude oil pipeline, the installation of new pumping station facilities and tankage at Enbridge's Beaver Lodge Station and Stanley Station, as well as additional tankage at Enbridge's Berthold Station.

On July 5, 2011, Enbridge filed a request for route deviations in Sections 19 and 20, Township 156N, Range 86W in Ward County and in Section 24, Township 156N, Range 87W, in Ward County, North Dakota. On July 29, 2011, Enbridge filed an application for an amended certificate of corridor compatibility, an amended route permit, and application for waivers of procedures and time schedules. The corridor and route changes are requested to provide a buffer zone around a missile silo site and to provide additional temporary workspace to facilitate new pipeline depth requirements at a railway line crossing. The proposed deviations are shown on the attached map.

In its application for waivers of procedures and time schedules, Enbridge requests that the Commission waive the following:

- Procedures that require separate filings of applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit,
- Procedures that require separate notices of such applications,
- Procedures that require separate hearings on such applications,
- Procedures that require a public hearing on an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility,
- Procedures that require a public hearing on an application for a route permit.

The issues to be considered in Enbridge's application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues to be considered in Enbridge's applications for amended certificate of corridor compatibility and amended route permit are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

Those interested are invited to comment on the applications in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by September 6, 2011.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.

An **Informal Hearing** of this matter is scheduled to begin on **August 24, 2011, at 3:00 p.m. CDT** in the Commission Hearing Room on the 12th floor of the State Capitol. At the informal hearing, the Commission will discuss this matter with the parties and interested members of the public.
