

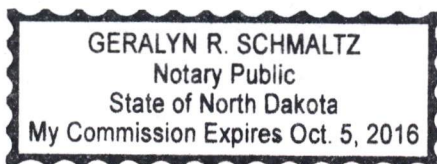

**NOTICE OF FILINGS, NOTICE OF INFORMAL HEARING, AND NOTICE OF
OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

May 17, 2012

The North Dakota Public Service Commission's (Commission) May 18, 2011 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued to Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (Enbridge) a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and a Route Permit for the construction of the Beaver Lodge Loop Project (Project) located in Williams, Mountrail, and Ward Counties, North Dakota. The Project consists of approximately 56 miles of 16-inch diameter pipeline and additional pump station facilities and tankage at Enbridge's existing Beaver Lodge, Stanley, and Berthold Stations.

In the May 18, 2011 Order the Commission granted Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 119 and Route Permit No. 129, providing in part: Construction along 61st Street NW between State Highway 8 and 82nd Avenue NW will not begin until Enbridge has submitted an Application for a route deviation in this area with sufficient materials showing that any modification of the corridor meets the requirements of the North Dakota Energy Conversion and Transmission Facility Siting Act and has received approval from the Commission to proceed.

On April 30, 2012, Enbridge submitted an Application for a route deviation for construction along 61st Street NW between State Highway 8 and 82nd Avenue NW in Section 33, Township 156 North, Range 91 West, in Mountrail County, North Dakota. On May 10, 2012, Enbridge filed an application for an amended certificate of corridor compatibility, an application for an amended route permit, and an application for waivers of procedures and time schedules. On May 14, 2012 Enbridge filed a revised route deviation application. The corridor and route changes are shown on the attached map.

In its application for waivers of procedures and time schedules, Enbridge requests that the Commission waive the following:

- Procedures that require separate filings of applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit,
- Procedures that require separate notices of such applications,
- Procedures that require separate hearings on such applications,
- Procedures that require a public hearing on an application for a certificate of corridor compatibility,

- Procedures that require a public hearing on an application for a route permit.

The issues to be considered in Enbridge's application for waiver of procedures and time schedules are:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?

The issues to be considered in Enbridge's applications for amended certificate of corridor compatibility and amended route permit are:


1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

Those interested are invited to comment on the applications in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by June 15, 2012.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.




