The North Dakota Public Service Commission's (Commission) May 18, 2011 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued to Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (Enbridge) a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and a Route Permit for the construction of the Beaver Lodge Loop Project (Project) located in Williams, Mountrail, and Ward Counties, North Dakota. The Project consists of approximately 56 miles of 16-inch diameter pipeline and additional pump station facilities and tankage at Enbridge's existing Beaver Lodge, Stanley, and Berthold Stations.

In the May 18, 2011 Order the Commission granted Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 119 and Route Permit No. 129, which included Paragraph 8 of the Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications incorporated into the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, and stated, "The width of clear cuts through windbreaks, shelterbelts and all other wooded areas shall be limited to 50 feet or less unless otherwise approved by the Commission."

In a letter dated May 2, 2012 Enbridge requests that the Commission amend Paragraph 8 of the Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications for Tract Numbers BB-82-18, BB-82-19-1, BB-82-20-3 and BB-82-21-1 on the west half of Enbridge's Beaver Lodge Loop Project, and requests an increase in clearing of trees and/or shrubs from a width of 50 feet to 125 feet, restricted to a length of approximately 200 feet on Tract BB-82-18, approximately 200 feet on Tract BB-82-19-1, and a combined 1500 feet on Tracts BB-82-20-3 and BB-82-21-1. All affected locations by this amended Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications are located wholly within Mountrail County, North Dakota.

The issues to be considered in Enbridge's request for an amended certificate of corridor compatibility and amended route permit are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations

minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

Those interested are invited to comment on the applications in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by June 28, 2012. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.

An Informal Hearing of this matter is scheduled to begin on June 20, 2012 at 1:45 p.m. CDT in the Commission Hearing Room on the 12th floor of the State Capitol. At the informal hearing, the Commission will discuss this matter with the parties and interested members of the public.

The Three Affiliated Tribes will receive separate sealed bids for the construction of Fort Berthold Rural Water, New Town Areas 2 & 4, Contract 2012-1 at the 4 Bears Casino Meetings Rooms, New Town, ND until 1:30 P.M., Local Time on the 19th day of June, where and at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of WORK generally consists of furnishing and installing approximately 1.7 miles of 10" AWWA C-900 PVC gasketed joint pipe; 32 miles of 10" - 1 1/2" ASTM D2241 PVC gasketed joint pipe; 169 services; road crossings; railroad crossings, connections to existing pipelines, and other related appurtenances. The project is located in Mountrail County of North Dakota generally north and east of the City of New Town.

Each BID must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a copy of a current and valid North Dakota Contractor's License (must have been issued at least 10 calendar days before the date of Bid opening) and a BIDDER's Bond equal to five percent of the full amount of the BID, executed by the BIDDER as Principal and by a SURETY, conditioned that if the Principal's BID is accepted and the CONTRACT awarded to the Principal, the Principal, within fifteen days after notice of award, shall execute a CONTRACT in accordance with terms of the BID and a CONTRACTOR's BOND as required by law and the regulations and determinations of the Three Affiliated Tribes.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the Presidents Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the contract documents.

In the evaluation of bids, the Three Affiliated Tribes will give preference in the amount of 2% above the lowest responsive bid received to Certified Indian Contractors.

Bidders shall follow Tribal Employment Rights Office regulations. Notice is hereby given to any and all Contractors who bid on projects on trust land within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Berthold Reservation that you are responsible for payment of Tribal Tax, which amounts to two and a half percent (2.5%) of the gross receipts from each Prime Contract.

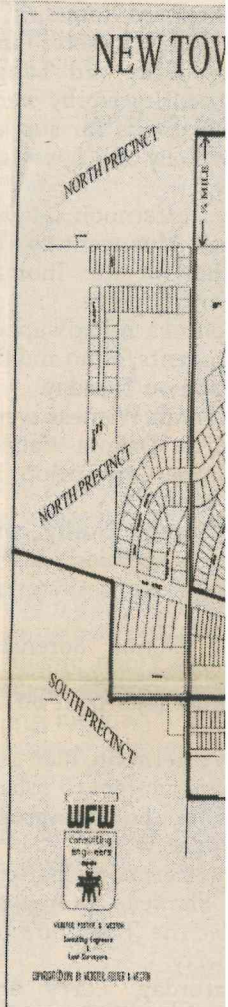
