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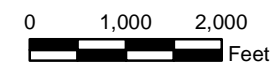

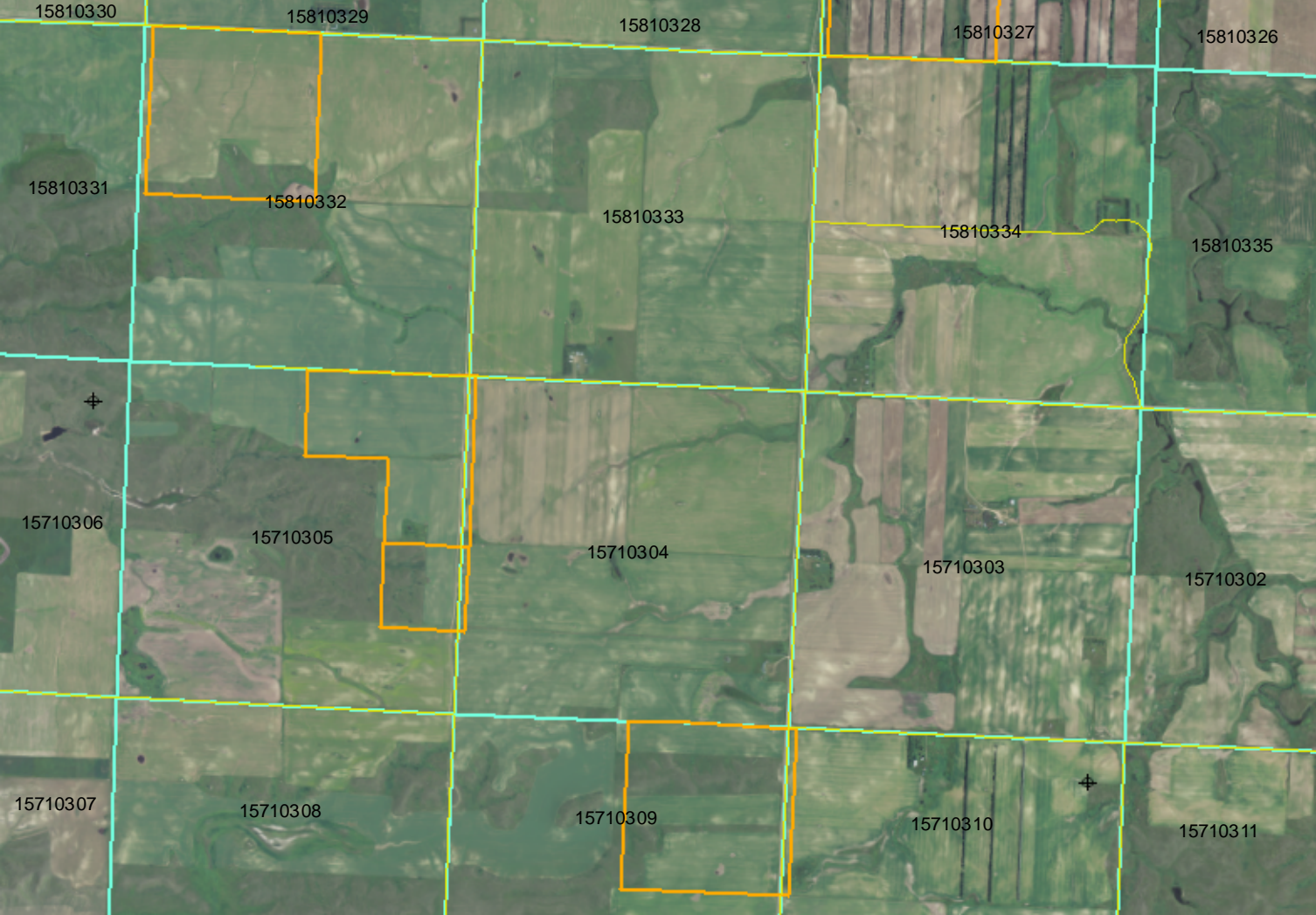
**Figure 1**

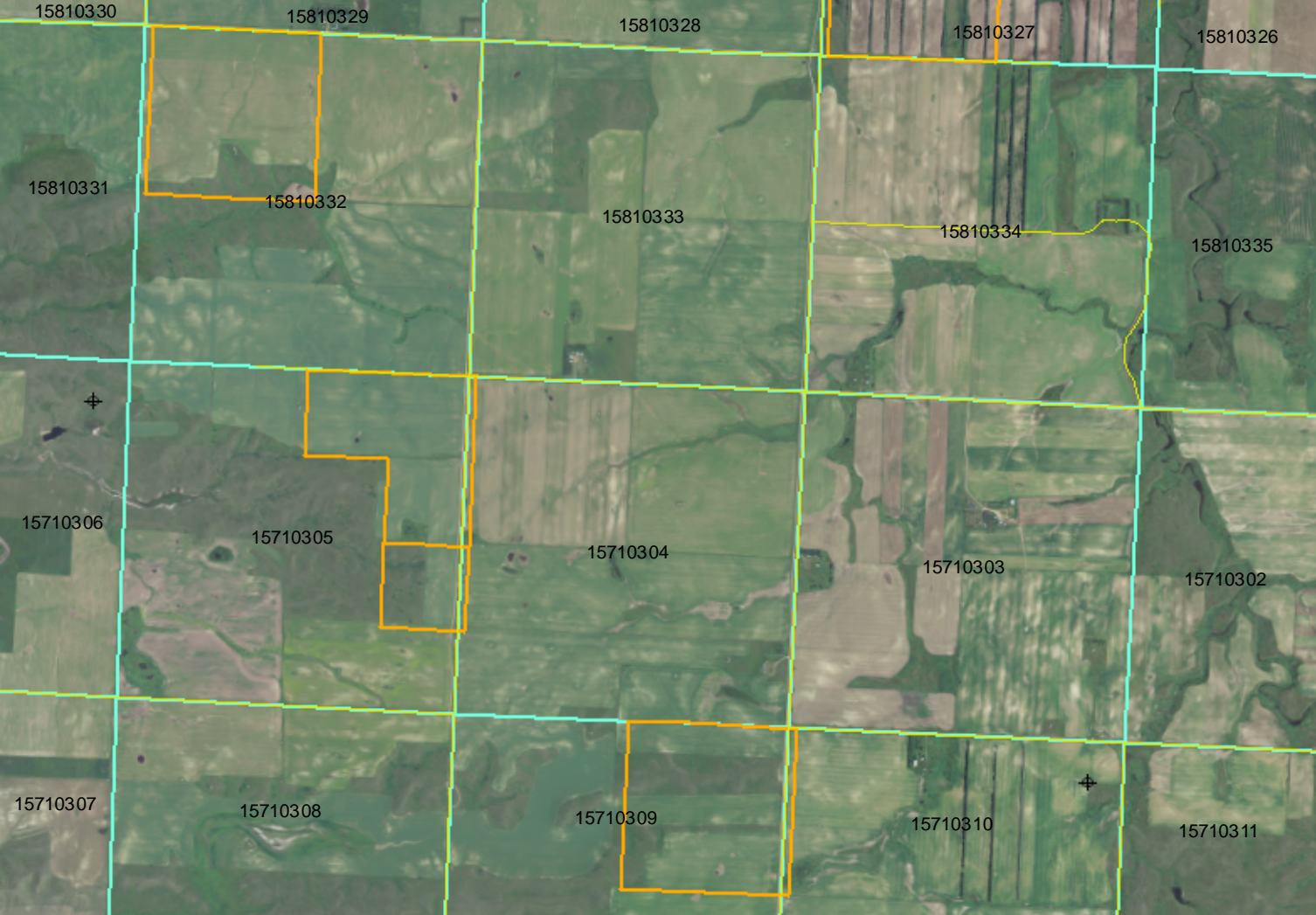

Plains All-American Pipeline (Plains) has proposed the construction of the Bakken North Pipeline, The proposed Project will provide firm crude oil transportation service from its origin at the connection of Plains Trenton Gathering System in west central Williams County and extend to an interconnect with an existing pipeline near Outpost, Montana. The proposed project covers a distance of approximately 32 miles in Williams County, North Dakota.
