Mayor Skarphol called the meeting to order. Council members present were: Virginia Sillerud, Darcy Hanson, Greg Knopp, Water Superintendent's Keith and Ellen Rossmiller, and Auditor Susan Jacobson. Several residents of the City of Wildrose and outlying area were also in attendance.

Truck Ordinance: A discussion on the truck ordinance was held by those attending the meeting. Several ideas were discussed, including an industrial area for the trucks to park. Also, a truck route was discussed, so that the truck drivers would know where they can drive their trucks in town. No parking areas were also a topic of discussion. All attending agreed that some restrictions need to be put in place, otherwise there will no longer be any drivable streets in town. The first reading of the ordinance was tabled until council members have more time to go over the ordinance and make changes that

they see fit. A special meeting will be held on May 9, 2011 for the first reading of the ordinance.

Art Glasoe made a request to build a 24' x 80' truck barn on the railroad property by the elevator that he is purchasing. This barn would be heated, with a pressure wash stall and a stall to work on trucks. He would also like to have some units with electricity, possibly 8-10 units. He agreed there would be no idling of trucks in this area. Tabled until the next meeting.

Richard Skor and Scott Pearson gave the council the requested application for a beer/liquor license. This license would be used for a future steakhouse in the building that housed the school and possibly off sale beer. The request was tabled for further consideration.

Steve Charland made a request to put in four water supply units with sewer on two lots, with two units per lot. He would then put FEMA trailers on the lots. The trailers will be 12'x40' and/or 8' x 35' that will house his employees. The council agreed to this proposal.

Summer maintenance position was discussed. Marlene and Manny Hedrickson will do the summer mowing and maintenance for the city.

Russell Trucking representative's joined the meeting. They discussed with the council members the need to find a place to park their trucks, so that the trucks would be off the streets. Some possibilities were discussed and they will look into it.

Duane Frantzick discussed with the city the various options that they have to repair the streets and the drainage problem that exists. At this time, it was decided that until the need to get the trucks off the streets was met, Duane should blade the streets and get the streets drivable. Duane agreed to this.

The monthly bills were presented and the minutes to the previous month were read. Sillerud made a motion to pay the bills as presented and also approved the minutes. Hanson seconded the motion. Carried.

Sillerud made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Knopp seconded the motion. Carried.

R & T Water Supply Association Meeting

Mayor Skarphol called the meeting to order. Council members present were: Virginia Sillerud Greg Knopp, Darcy Hanson, Water Superintendents Keith and Ellen Rossmiller, and Auditor Susan Jacobson. R & T Water Supply representatives in attendance were Jerry Ranum and Greg Larson. Other attending the meeting were Hal Hickel.

In a discussion held on how R & T Water Supply can help the City of Wildrose maintain their water, it was agreed that R & T Water Supply will take over the water sampling for the city as of July 1, 2011. The sampling

bottles will be sent to Greg Larson and the billing and results will be sent to the City of Wildrose, with the city faxing the results to the R & T Water Supply office.

In other discussion, Greg Larson told the city council and the water superintendents that we need to flush out the mains to get all of the old residue of previous water out of the mains.

The rural connections were questioned. Rural connections will be metered by R & T Water Supply with using a R & T/City of Wildrose purchase agreement if done before the city turns the transmission line over the R & T Water Supply. After that the R & T Water Supply purchase agreement will be used. A two inch line can be used, but a five gallon per minute restricter will be installed.

It was also noted, that after this last storm, whereas there was no power for a couple of days, an automatic generator system is needed at the tower.

Hal Hickel questioned if he would be able to receive water off of the City of Wildrose's transmission line for a new development that he is proposing. It was agreed that this would be possible. Hal will be working with R & T Water Supply on this, as they will own the transmission line at that time.

With no further business, Sillerud made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Hanson seconded the motion. Carried.
