NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING

The public hearing scheduled for May 20, 2011, on the applications of Rangeland Pipeline, LLC for a certificate of corridor compatibility and a route permit to authorize construction for approximately 20 miles of 8-inch crude oil pipeline in Williams County, North Dakota was continued on May 11, 2011. It is now rescheduled to be held on August 31, 2011, beginning at 10:00 a.m. CDT, in the Tioga City Hall, 12 1st Street NE, Tioga, North Dakota 58852. The issues to be considered are as follows:

1. Is the proposed facility of such length, design, location, or purpose that it will produce minimal adverse effects, or, does a demonstrable emergency exist which requires immediate construction and that adherence to the procedures and time schedules would jeopardize the utilities system?

2. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

3. Are the proposed facilities

compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?

4. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

Rangeland also filed a request for waiver of procedures and time schedules established under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-22 and North Dakota Administrative Code Chapter 69-09-06. The Commission has found the applications are complete.
