On November 24, 2011, Rangeland Pipeline, LLC reported damage that occurred on November 24, 2011 to a 3-inch crude oil pipeline owned by Amerada Hess northeast of the intersection of 107th Ave NW and 60th St. NW in West Bank Township, Williams County, North Dakota.

Commission staff has determined Rangeland's compliance with One-Call Excavation Notice System requirements under North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-23. In addition, Rangeland has identified mitigation measures that will be used by Rangeland in areas where Rangeland expects possible unmarked buried utilities.
