Post Inspection Report Compliance**

The North Dakota Public Service Commission's September 29, 2011 Order in Case No. PU-10-637 designated to Rangeland Pipeline, LLC (aka Inergy Dakota Pipeline, LLC and Crestwood Dakota Pipelines, LLC) a corridor and route for the location of a 20.5 mile underground pipeline in Williams County, North Dakota. The Commission retained a third-party vendor to conduct construction inspections of the project.

On August 27, 2015, the Commission received the vendor's construction inspection report. Listed here are actions recommended in the report for follow-up by the Company to confirm compliance with the Commission's Order.

- According to the Certification Relating to Order Provisions for Transmission Facility Siting signed by the Company, the Company agreed to provide copies of all licenses and permits to the Commission prior to construction. Based on Exhibit 10 as submitted at the hearing, the Company may have needed permits from: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers; North Dakota Department of Health (NDDH); North Dakota Department of Transportation; North Dakota State Land Department; North Dakota State Water Commission; and the Williams County Highway Department. In order to comply with the certification, item number 4, copies of all permits needed for this project must be filed with the Commission.
- On October 6, 2011 Rangeland Pipeline informed the Commission of their intent to start construction on October 7, 2011 (Docket #76). Rangeland Pipeline submitted weekly progress reports via email to the Commission starting with Docket # 78 throughout the construction process. The weekly progress reports for the weeks ending 6-28-2012, 7-19-2012, 8-2-2012, 8-9-2012, 8-16-2012, 9-6-2012, 9-13-2012, and 10-8-2012 are missing. In

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order to comply with the certification, item number 5, these documents must be filed with the Commission.

- In order to comply with Certification Relating to Order Provisions for Transmission Facility Siting point 17, documentation of re-vegetation surveys and noxious weed surveys must be filed with the Commission.
- The construction inspection report also notes that the Company has not yet complied with the Commission's tree and shrub mitigation requirements. This was discussed in my August 28, 2015 letter to Lawrence Bender.
