Section 15, Twp 156 N, R 92 W, Mountrail County, North Dakota.


Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **March 14, 2011**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
