(8299) ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING, RAMSEY COUNTY COMMISSION TUESDAY, MAY 17, 2011 5:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Joe Belford, Chairman. Roll call was taken and the following members were present: Commissioners Diseth, Brown, Olson, Mertens & Belford. The board & visitors recited the pledge of allegiance.

Motion was made by Commissioner Brown, seconded by Commissioner Olson to approve the minutes of the May 10, 2011 meeting. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Roger Gunderson, Maintenance Supervisor, presented proposals for redoing the floor tiles and installation in the armory (Thompsons \$4,626 and LaMottes \$5,740) and removal of tiles (Gary Snow \$5,245 and Building Systems GF \$5,800).

Motion was made by Commissioner Mertens, seconded by Commissioner Brown to approve the low bid from Thompson's Paint & Glass in the amount of \$4,626 for tile and Gary Snow in the amount of \$5,245 for removal of tile (asbestos). All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Kevin Fieldsend, Co Highway Superintendent, reported on the following: Mud jacking culvert on RC#3 costing approximately \$3,500.00 Tony Nordin wants to put a culvert in an approach on the north side of RC#2 east of town - thought this approach had enough culverts to handle the flow but doesn't

Motion was made by Commissioner Diseth, seconded by Commissioner Olson to approve Tony Nordin to install a 24" culvert in an approach on the north side of RC#2 east of town with no expense to the county. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Brown, seconded by Commissioner Olson to appoint Kevin Fieldsend, Co Highway Superintendent as applicant agent for 2011 FEMA Disaster and to be compensated for any overtime worked within the project. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mertens, seconded by Commissioner Olson to have a Special Meeting on Monday, May 23, 2011 at 8:00 a.m. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Brown, seconded by Commissioner Mertens to approve cutting edges costing approximately \$12,400.00. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Discussion on Rip/Rap on the Benson/Ramsey County line road. Kevin will check on this to transfer funds to other areas.

Kristen Nelsen, Emergency Management, reported that the intern will start on Monday, May 23, 2011 and that the grant was approved through the ND DES - the amount of \$5,000 with the sub-grantee share of \$1,000 with an 80/20 match.

The Lake Region Heritage Center Board was present to update the board on the operation and plans for staying open during the upcoming months. Upcoming events are pie social, jewelry sale and ice cream social. They will continue to receive quarterly funding from the City of Devils Lake and in the fall request the County Commission to do a resolution to place on the ballot a .50 mill increase to the voters of Ramsey County in the 2012 election year. Eunice Davidson is applying for grants - through the ND State Historical Society.

Motion was made by Commissioner Diseth, seconded by Commissioner Olson to deny the request from LR Grain for a special permit to have anhydrous ammonia tankers delivered to the Rohrville Station this spring at 80,000 lbs. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Diseth, seconded by Commissioner Mertens to reappoint Commissioner Olson to the LR Heritage Center Board. All members voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Brown,

COLLABORATIVE BARGAINING UP-DATE. Mike Klemetsrud noted that the Administrative Collaborative Bargaining Team came to a tentative agreement at their meeting this morning. He also noted that the Teacher Collaborative Bargaining Team will meet again on Thursday, May 12th. Dr. Swiontek noted that he and Scott have been meeting with a group of classified staff members regarding the implementation of a classified staff salary schedule for our district.

SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS. The principals were on hand to discuss the summer school programs to be offered for the Devils Lake Elementary Schools, Central Middle School and Devils Lake High School (NESC). The Elementary and Middle School programs will run from May 31-June 23, and the high school program will run June 1-24, 2011. Mike Klemetsrud moved to approve the summer school programs for 2011. Motion seconded by Steve Halldorson. Motion carried unanimously.

CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION. Steve Halldorson moved to approve the list of 154 candidates for graduation, pending successful completion of the course of study as prescribed by the Devils Lake Public School Board. Motion seconded by Kory Boehmer. Motion carried unanimously. Graduation will be held on Sunday, May 29, at 2:00 PM at the Sports Center, and Senator John Hoeven will be the speaker.

RESOLUTION REGARDING FLEXIBLE BENEFITS PLAN. Scott Privratsky noted the need to update our Section 125 Flexible Benefits Plan Document due to changes in Health Care Reform and reviewed the resolution to be adopted by the board. Following review, Steve Boone moved to adopt the Board Resolution Adoption Plan for the 125 Flexible Benefits Plan. Motion seconded by Mike Klemetsrud. Motion carried unanimously.

BUS BIDS. Dr. Swiontek reviewed the bus bids received on March 16, 2011 and noted that he was holding on a recommendation until he knew if we were going to receive the Clean Diesel Grant which could have paid that we go ahead with the purchase of another route bus at this time. Following discussion, Mike Klemetsrud moved to accept the bid from Hartley's School Buses for the purchase of a 2012 BlueBird Vision 59-passenger bus at a cost of \$80,755. Motion seconded by Kory Boehmer. Motion carried unanimously.

RESPONSIBLE USE OF TECHNOLOGY POLICY. Mike DeFoe requested that the Board approve the revised Responsible Use of Technology Policy for the Devils Lake Public School District. Following review, Mike Klemetsrud moved to approve the Responsible Use of Technology Policy. Motion seconded by Steve Boone. Motion carried unanimously.

PERSONNEL MATTERS. Kory Boehmer moved to accept the resignation of Jordan King-PhyEd Teacher at Sweetwater & Minnie H Elementary School, effective the end of the 2010-11 school year. Motion seconded by Steve Halldorson. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Halldorson then moved to approve the appointment of Kyle Regynski as the new Instructional Strategist at Devils Lake High School. Motion seconded by Kory Boehmer. Motion carried unanimously.
