FOR RENEWAL OF A SOLID WASTE MAN-
AGEMENT FACILITY PERMIT UNDER THE
NORTH DAKOTA SOLID WASTE MAN-
AGEMENT RULES

FACILITY NAME: IHD Solids Management,
LLC - Permit 0088
APPLICANT: Jon McCreary, President of IHD
Solids Management, LLC

BACKGROUND:
On May 2, 2011, the Department received a
revised solid waste management facility per-
mit renewal application from IHD Solids Man-
agement, LLC (IHD). The facility was formerly
permitted to "Indian Hills Disposal, LLC." The
ownership of the company controlling the ex-
isting Indian Hills Disposal, Inc. solid waste
management facility, regulated by the Depart-
ment under Permit 0088, has changed. The
new owner of the company formed another
company who proposes to operate this facility
with significant modifications in facility design,
size and operation.

IHD is proposing to laterally expand the solid
waste management facility to the east to in-
clude an additional thirty (30) acres that
would bring the facility's total permitted acre-
age to approximately 87.1 acres. The facility
is located southwest of Williston in the NW1/4
of Section 34, Township 153N, Range 101W,
McKenzie County.

IHD proposes to construct a new special and
small volume industrial waste landfill unit
which will have a composite liner (clay and
synthetic components). IHD also proposes to
continue using an existing waste pile unit for
the storage and treatment of oily waste until
the proposed landfill has been approved and
constructed. Upon approval for use of the
newly constructed landfill unit, IHD will dis-
pose all stored waste from the waste pile unit
into the new landfill unit and then appropri-
ately close the existing waste pile unit. The
facility will continue to be used for manage-
ment and disposal of oil field exploration and
production (special) wastes, other oily waste
materials, certain industrial wastes and inert
waste. The proposed facility would also in-
clude a surface impoundment unit for storing
and evaporating leachate.

The Department believes that a permit which
meets the requirements of the North Dakota
Solid Waste Management Rules and is pro-
tective of human health and the environment
can be issued to IHD Solids Management,
LLC and has prepared a Draft Permit for pub-
lic review and comment.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND HEARING

As required by Section 33-20-03.1-03 of the
North Dakota Administrative Code, the Draft
Permit will be available for public review and
comment for thirty (30) days following publi-
cation of the Public Notice. Public comment
begins June 3, 2011 and ends July 5, 2011.
During that period any interested person may
submit written comments and request a pub-
lic hearing by stating the nature of the specific
issues to be raised. If the Department deter-
mines that there is sufficient public interest
pertinent to the proposed permit and a hear-
ing is requested, a public hearing will be con-
ducted on July 13, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. in the
Meeting Room of the McKenzie County
Courthouse located at 201 West 5th Street,
Watford City, ND. If sufficient interest is not
raised, the hearing will not be conducted.
The North Dakota Department of Health will
consider all comments prior to taking any ac-
