**Dear Licensee,**

**As of 7/8/11 your 2011-2012 license renewal application has not been received. If your firm intends to remain in business, please submit your license renewal application and required items to our office at your earliest convenience. State law provides that license renewal application received after July 15 must be assessed an additional \$100 fee per warehouse/license.**

**License renewal applications not received in a timely manner will result in the automatic discontinuance of business. Grain warehousemen and facility-based grain buyers not intending to renew a license(s) must file a request to discontinue business. The form is available at <http://www.psc.nd.gov/forms/grain/request-to-discontinue-businesss.pdf> or by contacting our office. Roving grain buyers not intending to renew a license must submit a written request asking to cancel the license.**
