Boats need 2011-13 registration

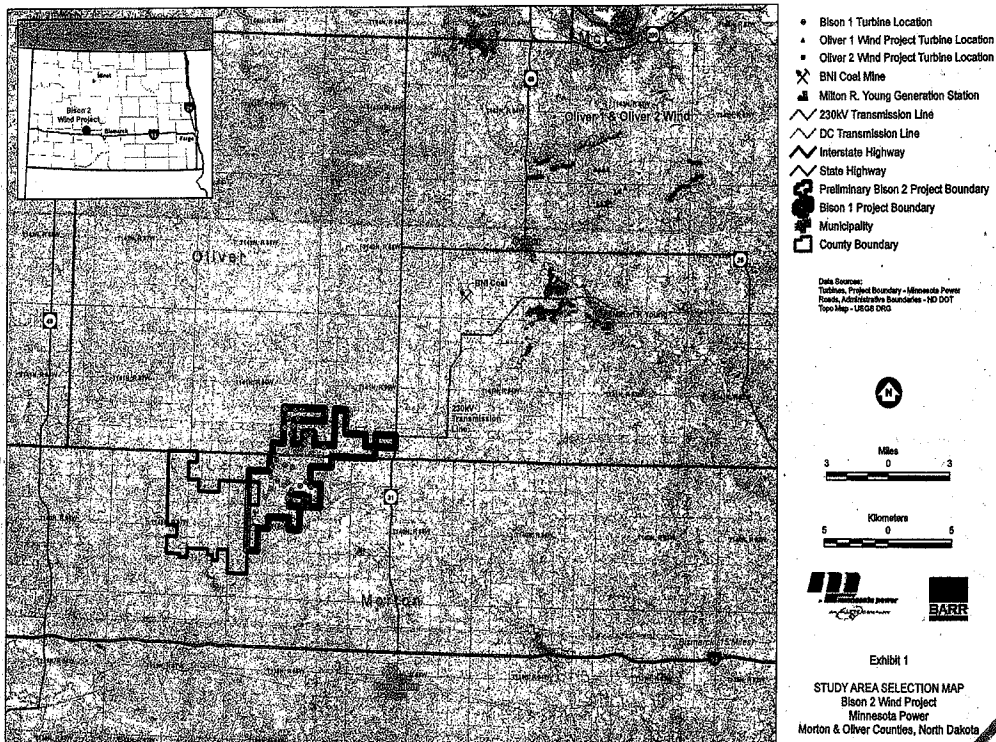
Boat owners are reminded that 2011 is the first year of the new three-year registration period. All boat registrations with an orange decal expired Dec. 31, 2010.

The new registration cycle runs through Dec. 31, 2013. New blue and white boat validation stickers have the expiration year of 13 prominently readable in the middle of the sticker.

Renewal notices for the current three-year period

were mailed in December. Boat owners who have not received a renewal notice, or have misplaced it, should contact the department by email at ndgf@nd.gov, or call 328-6335.
