Good afternoon! Attached are aerial photos of several ND School Trust surface tracts that lie within the proposed Bear Paw Energy - Garden Creek Pipeline project and listed below are the ND Land Departments comments in regards to the surface impacts and routing of the pipeline. An onsite inspection may be needed to determine the suitability of a proposed corridor and to determine such items as underground boring certain segments. Let me know if you have questions. Thanks.

151-99-36 SE4: Section 36 & 25 are included in a 1280 acre oil spacing unit, potential oil well sites lie along the south section line. Potential for a pipeline corridor near the east-west half line but an onsite inspection to determine suitability is required.

150-99-16 N2: 640 acres oil spacing unit which means potential well sites around the perimeter of the section. Potential pipeline corridor on the east-west half line but an onsite inspection to determine suitability is required.

149-100-16 All: Section 16 & 21 are included in a 1280 acre oil spacing unit, potential oil well sites along the north section line, potential pipeline corridor near the east-west half line but an onsite inspection to determine suitability is required.

147-104-16 N2, SE4: There is an existing suitable pipeline corridor adjacent to and parallel with the oil well access road that runs southeast to northwest across this tract.

148-105-36 SW4: Very limited room for additional pipelines. Only potential would be very close to and parallel to the highway on this tract.

Mr. Haupt and Mr. Combs,

Bear Paw Energy, LLC (BPE), a subsidiary of ONEOK Partners, LP, Tulsa, Oklahoma, has proposed the Garden Creek NGL Pipeline Project. This project will entail the construction of approximately 55 miles of 12-inch diameter pipeline in McKenzie County, North Dakota and approximately 10 miles of pipeline in Richland County, Montana this pipeline will be designed to transport natural gas liquids (NGL) to various delivery points along the route. This project is currently scheduled to begin construction in July 2011 and will require a minimum of 90 days to complete construction with restoration to immediately follow. The planned pipeline corridor is shown on the attached map.

Pipeline construction activities will typically occupy a 100-foot right of way. Following construction, the pipeline will occupy a 50-foot permanent right of way. To minimize impacts portions of the proposed route will be collocated with existing utility corridors.

Please provide comments regarding the presence of School Trust Lands or State Mineral Trust Lands located within a one mile of the proposed Project corridor. E3 will utilize this information in the preparation of a Public Service Commission application for the project. E3 has been retained by APL to provide environmental consulting support for this project. Please contact myself by phone or email if additional information is required.

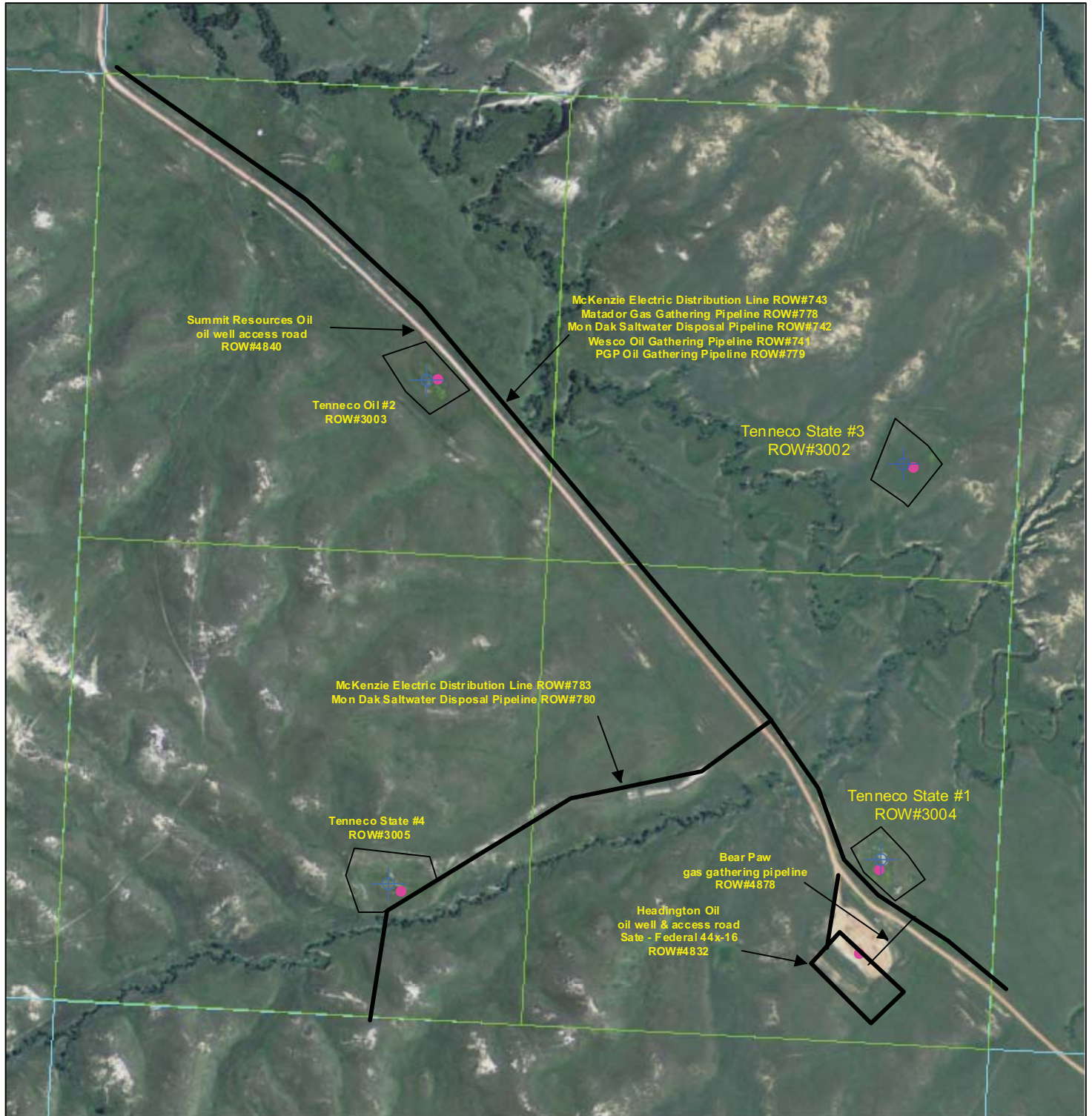

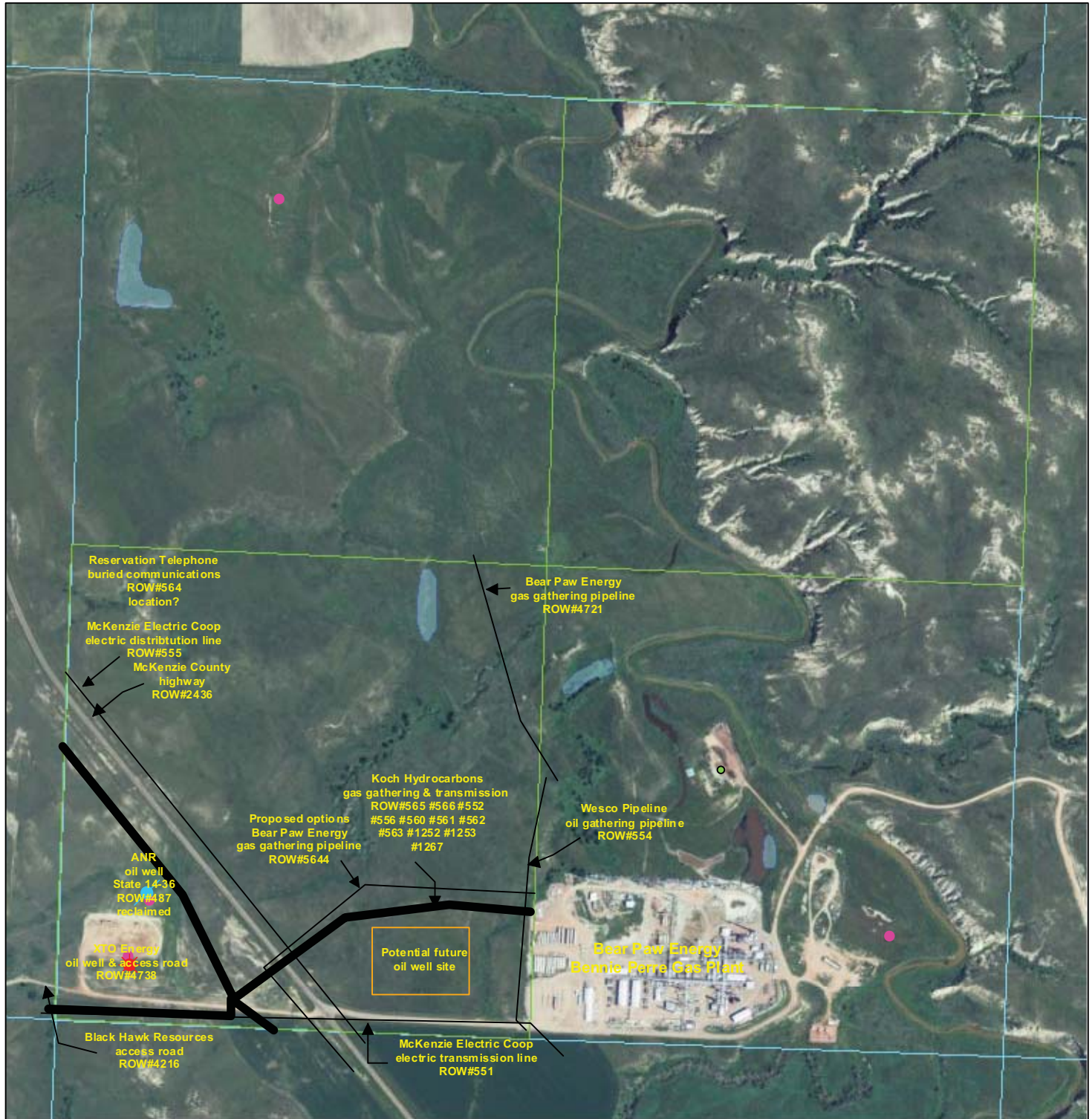

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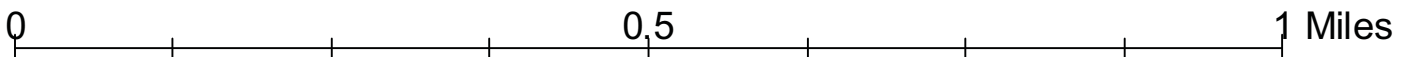

Township: Ideal



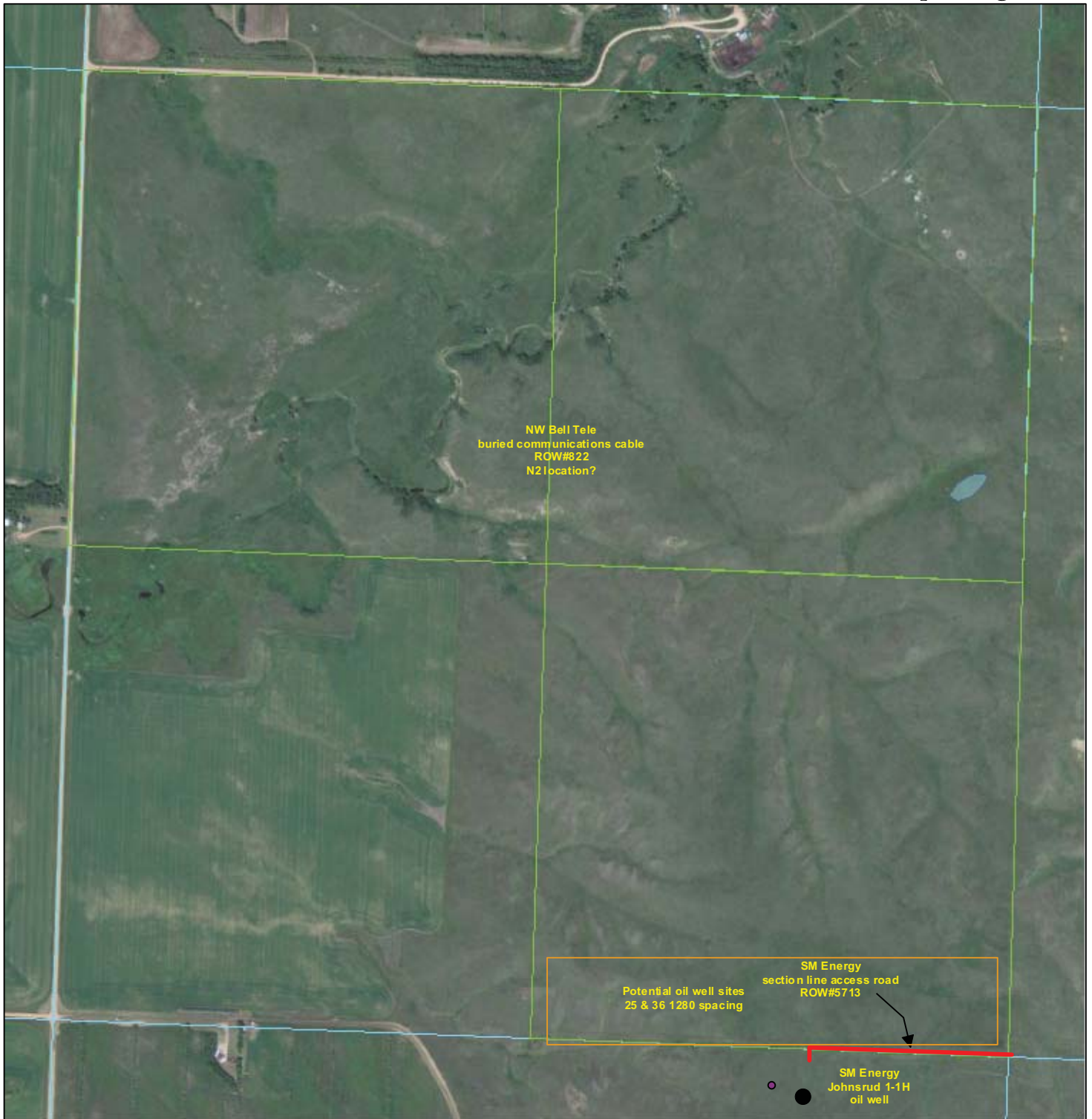

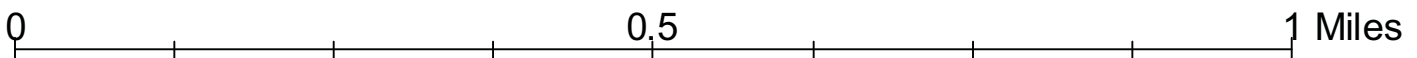
