Agenda: Thompson added to new busi-
ness liability insurance for the 125th
Centennial. Wollenzien/Berdahl M/S to
approve the agenda with the added new
business. Carried.

Minutes: Wollenzien/Suchor M/S to
approve the minutes of the May 2, 2011
meeting. Carried.

Bills: Suchor/Carpenter M/S to
approve the bills as presented. Carried.
