However, the Traill County Board has no mechanism for generating revenue for maintaining these improvements. The Joint Board recognizes how important these im- provements are for the landowners, ag producers, residents, and commu- nities in the Elm River Watershed. Un- fortunately, without a revenue source to maintain these improvements, the projects will deteriorate and will no longer benefit the watershed, and the dams in particular may create safety hazards if not properly maintained, a possibility without adequate mainte- nance funds. With that in mind, the Joint Board is seeking to create a maintenance district for purposes of operating and maintaining these im- provements.

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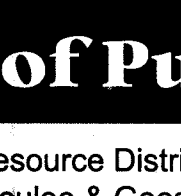

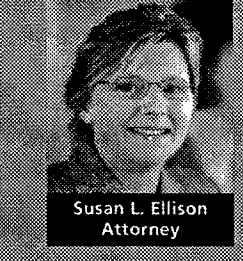
