On March 23, 2011 New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (New Cingular), a subsidiary of AT&T Mobility LLC, filed an Application for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support in North Dakota. New Cingular is a Delaware limited liability company whose principal place of business is located in Atlanta, Georgia. New Cingular has acquired certain licenses and assets that Verizon Wireless held to serve portions of North Dakota. Qualification of the applicant under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Section 214(e) for designation as an ETC eligible to receive federal universal service funding. 2. What ETC universal service support area should be designated. 3. The public interest.

Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearings must be received by June 3, 2011. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.

An informal hearing on this matter has been scheduled for June 22, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. CDT in the Commission Hearing Room on the 12th Floor of the State Capitol in Bismarck.
