On March 23, 2011 New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (New Cingular), a subsidiary of AT&T Mobility LLC, filed an Application for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support in North Dakota. New Cingular is a Delaware limited liability company whose principal place of business is located in Atlanta, Georgia. New Cingular has acquired certain licenses and assets that Verizon Wireless held to serve portions of North Dakota.
