ORDER FOR ADMISSION TO PRACTICE *PRO HAC VICE*


On June 17, 2011, Thomas D. Kelsch, of the firm of Kelsch, Kelsch, Ruff & Kranda, filed a Motion for Admission of Non-Resident Attorney to Participate, and Affidavit of Betsy S. Granger, with AT&T Services, Inc.. Ms. Granger seeks admission to practice *pro hac vice* in North Dakota, representing New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, before the Public Service Commission in Case No. PU-11-86. On June 21, 2011, Administrative Law Judge Allen C. Hoberg was designated to preside as procedural hearing officer in New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, PU-11-86, and was requested to rule on Ms. Granger's motion. The administrative law judge has reviewed Ms. Granger's motion and affidavit and finds that she has met the requirements of the North Dakota Supreme Court Admission to Practice Rule 3 for admission *pro hac vice* to practice in North Dakota before the Public Service Commission in New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC. Accordingly, Mr. Kelsch's motion is granted and it is **ordered** that Betsy S. Granger of AT&T Services, Inc. may practice in North Dakota before the Public Service Commission, representing New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, in PU-11-86.
