NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

February 15, 2012

On November 2, 2011, in Case No. PU-11-99, the Commission issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 126 and Route Permit No. 135 to Arrow Field Services, LLC authorizing construction and operation of 1.5 miles of eight-inch crude oil pipeline with associated facilities and pipeline interconnections in McKenzie County, North Dakota.

On January 26, 2012, Arrow Field Services, LLC (Arrow) and Banner Transportation Company, LLC (Banner) submitted a joint application for the transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 126 and Route Permit No. 135 to Banner, Case No. PU-12-47.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-12-47 are whether Banner Transportation Company, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the corridor certificate and the route permit issued to Arrow Field Services, LLC, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by **March 23, 2012**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
