PUBLIC NOTICE TO TAKE LAND "IN TRUST"

ACTION: Notice of final age determination to take land into trust under 25 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 151.1. SUMMARY: The Superintendent of Fort Totten Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior on the below date, has made a final determination to acquire real property "in trust" for the Spirit Lake Tribe.

DATE: This determination was made on May 9, 2011.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: This notice is published to comply with the requirement of 25 CFR, Part 151.1 that notice be given to the public of a decision by the authorized representative of the Secretary of the Interior to acquire land "in trust" at least 30 days prior to the signature acceptance of land "in trust" for the purpose of the 30-day waiting period to afford interested parties the opportunity to seek judicial review of administrative decisions to take land "in trust" for the tribe or individual Indians before transfer of the properties occurs. On May 9, 2011, the Superintendent issued a Decision Notice to accept land "in trust" for the Spirit Lake Tribe under the authority of the Act of January 12, 1983 (96 Stat. 2515) amended by the Act of October 30, 1996 (98 Stat. 3171).

The Superintendent, on behalf of the Secretary of the Interior, shall acquire title in the name of the United States of America in trust for Spirit Lake Tribe, North Dakota no sooner than 30 days after the initial date this notice is published in a newspaper.

The land referred to as former "Glenn Rue, Sr. (DLST-1163)" property, hereinafter described as: An undivided interest in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and also in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 11, T. 151 N., R. 66 E., 5th PM. in Benson County, North Dakota containing 80.0 acres more or less.
