 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Emmons County Commissioners will receive sealed bids for providing gravel loading and hauling for roads in Emmons County, North Dakota, for the year beginning July 12, 2011, through March 31, 2012. Bids are to be submitted on a per cubic yard basis for loads not to

exceed 20 cubic yards. Each bid shall show the cost for the first five miles, and the rate thereafter per cubic yard, with trucker also responsible for loading the gravel. A copy of current Contractor's License must accompany each bid and shall be submitted in an envelope separate from the Bid information. Each successful bidder must submit evidence of general liability insurance coverage prior to award of bid. 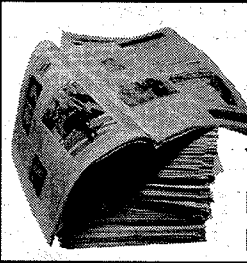
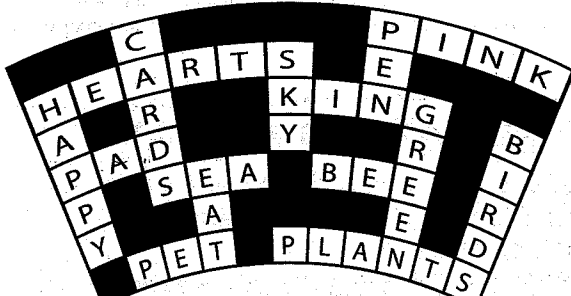
**Zeeland**
