Complaints shall contain the following information to facilitate investigations: the name, address, and telephone number or other means of contacting the person alleging discrimination; the location and name of the organization or office which is accused of discriminatory practices; the nature of the incident or action or the aspect of program administration that led the person to allege discrimination; the reason for the alleged discrimination (age, race, color, sex, handicap, religious creed, national origin, or political belief); the names, titles (if appropriate), and addresses of persons who may have knowledge of the alleged discriminatory acts; and the date or dates on which the alleged discriminatory actions occurred.

A complaint must be filed no later than 180 days from the date of the alleged discrimination. However, the time for filing may be extended by the Secretary.

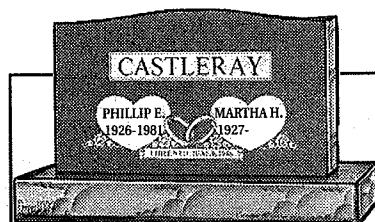
